

July 17 This day partly overcast and fresh S.W. winds under short sail boiling 34-32

July 18 This day fresh S.W. wind and a choppy sea overcast and rain. Lower Whales after school whales and got out in afternoon and set watches at night.

July 19 Overcast rain and strong S.W. winds ship under short sail first on starboard and then port tack. Boiling

July 20 This day overcast and rain strong wind S.W. under all sail but main'sail and jib top's and on port then starboard tack.

July 21 This day overcast in morning but clear in afternoon ship under short sail and on southern tack all day wind from same quarter and indicating signs of good weather

55-37 N. 32-48 N.

July 22 This day nearly all day calm rain. a school of bulls and girls chased with out success.

July 23 Very light to moderate S.W. winds under full sail and tack and tack 34-06

July 24 This day fair and light to moderate S.W. wind ship all day and night under short sail and steering S.E. by compass.

July 25 This day fine and smooth with a light wind from N.W. ship under full sail and on starboard tack until 7 a.m. then tack ship and steer S.W. until night shortened down to flying jib fore'sail and main try'sail

33-45 N. 49-29 N.

July 26 This day fine and smooth with a light S.W. wind ship under full sail and all day chasing whales that we raised in early morning. Lost sight of them in early afternoon shortened sail on starboard tack and lay under flying jib and main try'sail to the westward of us seen at night.

49-59 N. 33-58 N.

July 27 This day fresh S.W. winds choppy clear ship under short sail and on port and then starboard tacks. Saw Sch. "A.V.S. Woodruff" with 650 bbls of oil

34-09 N.

July 28 This day fair and strong to moderate winds under short sail all day and on S. tack at night were ship and shortened down
