

Sept 15 This day partly overcast and light to moderate S. to S.W. winds set all sail in early morning and steered by the wind until 4-30 P.M. then S.E. at night squally and rain

30-24. 38-08 A.

Sept 16 This day fair and fresh winds from S and S.W. ship made full sail and by the wind heading S.E. by compass. Land off sea return

28-12 A. 37-38 A.

Sept 17 This day partly overcast strong winds from S.E. and squally breeze school of bulls and hawks & set along-side by noon cut on in and leave other outside set fires

26-52 A. 37-13

Sept 18 This day fair and with a strong wind and light choppy sea cut in and set sail in afternoon by the wind on star board tack heading S.E. by compass.

26-41 A. 37-45 A.

Sept 19 Light winds from S.E. ship made full sail and by the wind on S. tack

26-47 A. 37-39 A.

Sept 20 Fair light winds from S.E. along N. Coast of St. Michaels

Sept 21 Nearly calm all day off E. point of S.M.

Sept 22 This day very light very light S. winds set all sail and star by the wind heading S.E. Land in sight in morning

Sept 23 Moderate winds squally and rain late calm ship on S.E. tack going but little.

Sept 24 This day fair and moderate S.W. winds raised school whales in early morning hove to fast alongside by noon cut in and then keep off & P.M. take in sail at night for rain squalls calm after squalls

36-00 - 21-50 A.

Sept 25 This day commenced with a very light S. wind rain and a grommet well run while forecable had to huff on account of small wind and slating boiling

35-20 - 21-15 A.

Sept 26 This day fresh to light S to S.W. winds ran ship to S. and E. at night wind shifted to S.E. stand to the eastward on starboard tack and under short sail

26-12 A. 34-50

Sept 26 Good moderate winds from S.E. ship on starboard tack heading S.E. by compass very light at night set all sail

18-40 A. 33-32 A.
