Fair and moderate trade well S. ship under full sail and by the wind heading S. S. W. Set fore rigging and repair shroud wind allowed ship to head better S. S. W. and S. S. S.

Dec. 2

Fair and moderate trades well S. under full sail and by the wind on port tack heading S. S. S.

2-46 S. 33-27 V.

Dec. 3

This day fair and with a moderate wind from S. and S. ship under full sail and by the wind on port tack heading S. S. W. repair fit to sail sight Rocas light in early morning

5-03 S. 33-59 V.

Dec. 4

Fair and moderate trades under full sail and by the wind until 4 P.M. then keep off S. S. S. Fair smooth sail and do various other small jobs

33-59 V. 7-12 S.

Dec. 5

This day fair and with a light wind from S. S. Under full sail and steering S. S. W. raise school of bulls at 8 am. lower boats and mate got fast to eye and parted line with snarl around loggerhead chase whales until 2:45 when they were out of sight to the N. E. keep off S. S. and lug at night under short sail and were ship at midnight

34-25 V. 8-20 S.

Dec. 6

Fair and moderate winds from S. S. make a couple of tack's under full sail in morning and then keep off S. S. and S. S. S. raise whales and chase from 3 P.M. until sun set without success. Board Swedish steamer "Hogland" and got news of war

8-20 S.

Dec. 7

Fair and fresh winds ship under full sail and by the wind in morning making a couple of tacks and then keep off S. S. S. see grampus

34-44 9-00 S.

Dec. 8

Fair and moderate good winds lighter at night. ship under full sail and steering S. S. W. At noon keep off S. S. by S. Repair flying fit

35-16 V. 11-18 S.

Dec. 9

Fairly overcast with a fresh to light S. S. wind squally. Raise whales at 7 am. get 5 small ones cut them in afternoon at about 6 P.M. While cutting saw whales again open Dec.
