

Jan. 3 This day fair and good fresh S.E. winds ship under full sail and on starboard tack all day or since morning heading S. by the wind at 9 - P.M. took ship and by the wind to the S.E. until morning took in fit to port and main to port

Jan. 4th

This day fair with moderate winds From N.E. to S.E. raised one whale in morning and chase all day to windward tack and tack After noon whale out of sight going fast to windward

37.31 N. 19.30 S.

Jan. 5

This day fair and with light to fresh N.E. winds ship under full sail and on port tack until 7 - am. then tack and steer full and by on starboard at 5 - P.M. raised whale lower boats but could not get to her going fast to windward. Hired boats at 7 - P.M. so ends

36.40 - 19.42

Jan. 6

This day fair and light winds from N.E. raised whale at day light and hove it fluked by 8 - 30 am. School of 3 bulls break fast and cut in whale done by 2 - P.M. start fire

19.24 S. 37.13 N

Jan. 7

This day fair and with a fresh wind from N.E. under full sail and on S.E. tack until at 6 - 4 M. and then tack and sail by the wind on S. tack all night in early morning took in main'sail on account of freshening of wind

36.55 N. 19.23 S.

Jan. 8

This day fresh winds with a choppy sea took in main'sail in early morning and set main try'sail sail her by the wind on starboard tack.

19.20 S. 37.03 N.

Jan. 9

This day fair and with a fresh wind N.E. set all sail in early morning and by the wind on starboard tack heading N. by E.

18.55 S. 37.54 N.

Jan. 10

N.E. trades under short sail and steer S.E. on one tack until 8 - am. and then W. and the other tack until night at 7 - P.M. left and lay on S. tack

37.24 N. 19.50 S.

Jan. 11

Overcast with squalls and a puffy wind ship under full sail and by the wind first on one tack and then the other lowered boat for fish at 8 - 30 P.M. and came on board at 4 - 30.

Jan. 12

This day partly overcast with a fresh N.E. wind ship all day under short sail and on S.E. tack full and by heading S.E. by E. See gram for and prepare

37.19 N. 19.41 S.

Jan. 13

This day commenced with a fresh N.E. wind and an occasional squall ship under main'sail and flying jib by the wind on port tack at 7 - 30 am. took ship and at 4 - 30 took in main'sail on account of light winds and a swell lay on S. tack all night

19.44 S. 37.10 N.
