

Jan. 14

This day partly overcast with a light wind from N.E. and a prominent swell set all sail and sail on starboard tack at noon found by an alt. ship in lat. S.

19-04 S. 37-36 N.

- " 15 Strong winds at times squally and rain in early morning ship under short sail and on N.E. tack were ship at night and lay on S.E. tack lowered boat for fish at 5³⁰ P.M.

18-57 S. 38-00 N.

- " 16 Fresh winds with occasional squall ship under full sail and working to windward tack and tack. Raised whales at 8-30 P.M. lower boat and give chase for the remainder of day without success. Stew down oil "casks. 334 - 246 - 284. 290 - 213 - 266

37-23 S. 19-37 S.

- " 17 Under full sail working to windward tack and tack under a light to moderate wind raised whales going to windward but no chance to lower boats

19-44 S. 37-11 N.

- " 18 Changeable weather ship under full sail with a moderate to fresh N.E. wind and fast on one tack and then the other

37-10 N. 19-31 N.

- " 19 Partly overcast with squalls choppy seas under full sail and by the wind on both tacks consecutively

19-58 S. 37-03 N.

Jan. 20

All day squally and rain ship under short sail and on starboard and then port tack

- " 21 This day partly overcast with squalls and rain wind from N.E. and fresh at times under full sail and by the wind

20-00 S. 37-14 N.

- " 22 This day strong winds with an occasional heavy squall saw whale twice, in early afternoon to windward of ship and going fast to windward and late in afternoon to leeward and going on same direction lower boats and got none kept ship on S.E. tack with wind well E.

19-38 S.

- " 23 Fair and fresh winds occasional squall with a lot of wind ship under full sail and on N. and E. tack with wind well to E. Saw whales at noon going fast to windward no chance to lower boats

37-31 N. 18-55 S.

Jan. 24

Fresh N.E. winds on E.N.E. ship under full sail and by the wind on E.E. tack heavy squalls at times and then an interval of nearly calm uncomfortable sailing

37-02 N. 19-41 S.

Jan. 25

Fair with fresh E.N.E. winds ship under full sail and on port tack by the wind heading E.E. heavy squalls and rain
