

Jan. 26

Fair with a fresh S.E. wind under full sail and on port tack heading S.E. by E. By night wind much lighter keep going to the S. and E.

34-57 W. 21-43 S.

Jan. 27

Fair and with light S. winds under full sail and on S.E. tack. Spoke S. Edward several days out from Seattle and bound for Dublin

34-06 W. 22-35 S.

Jan. 28

Fair with light wind from S. under all sail and on S. tack until noon and then S.E. many squalls during day

22-59 S.

Jan. 29

Squally and some rain with an easterly wind ship under full sail and on S.E. tack by the wind

23-25 S. 32-32 W.

Jan. 30

Light winds in morning and decreasing gradually until at night it was nearly calm keep all sail set and on S.E. tack at night tack ship and put her to the north

Jan. 31

This day light winds with a ground swell from N. ship under full sail and by the wind first on S.E. tack and at end of day put her on S. tack

30-54 W. 24-45 S.

Feb. 1st

This day fair and with a light wind ship under full sail and on starboard tack by the wind heading N. by E.

23-32 S.

Feb. 2

This day light wind from S.E. ship under full sail and by the wind on starboard tack heading N. Rain and squally

32-01 W. 22-55 S.

Feb. 3

This day squally with plenty rain and short spells of calm keep all sail and on S. tack heading N. by E. and N.E. by E.

32-06 W. 21-08 S.

Feb. 4

Fair and with fresh S.E. trades and an occasional squall ship under full sail by the wind on starboard tack heading N.E. and N. by E.

31-55 W. 19-47 S.

Feb. 5

S.E. trades quite fresh ship under all sail and by the wind on starboard tack making good headway

31-55 W. 17-42 S.

Feb. 6

Fair with moderate trades ship under full sail and by the wind on starboard tack heading N.E. by E. and N. by E. heavy squall occasionally

31-53 W. 15-34 S.

Feb. 7

Light trades ship under full sail and on S. tack by the wind and heading N. by E. later in the day took in main for repairs

31-51 W. 13-42 S.
