

Mar. 23rd

This day fair and very nice weather
ship under full sail and by the wind
on starboard tack heading N.E. by N.
Lee port N. by E for a sail and run
until 11:30 sail disappeared but again
by the wind and at noon tack on port
black wind 2. See nothing 14-17 N.

Mar. 24

Whale

This day fair to light winds ship under
full sail and cruising tack and
tack. Saw whale going to wind fair
no chance to land but saw it rise
rising and no more. Steamer going S.
13-36 N.

Mar. 25

Fair and very fresh to light winds and
again fresh ship under short sail
and cruising 14-04 N.

Mar. 26

This day fair with a fresh to moderate
wind & ship all day under short sail
and first on one tack and then
the other 14-53 N.

Mar. 27

Fair and strong to moderate
winds ship under short sail
and by the wind first on one
tack and then the other 14-00 N.

Mar. 28

Fresh winds ship under short sail and
on S. tack until noon and then N.
12-52 N. 42-28 N.

Mar. 29

White water

This day fair and with a fresh trade wind
ship under short sail until noon then set
main on account of white water a good
distance off and to windward beat the
afternoon but see no more of it shorten
down at night

Mar. 30

This day fair and with a fresh wind
ship under short sail and by the wind
on one tack and then the other & nothing
lay on South tack fair night.
13-21 N.

Mar. 31

This day strong winds from E. N. E. ship
under short sail in early morning set
main & and flying jib. Later jib top & j
after noon took in jib top & at night
shorten down to fore & and fore stay &
and main try & wind increased during
night lay on S. tack 13-45 N.

April 1st

Fore

This day fair and clear with a strong
wind from E. N. E. took in fore & jib
away and bend on new one at 10-
and. To see off S. N. under main try &
fore & fore top and flying jib. Wind
moderating at night luff on E. tack
14-00 N. 43-20 N.

April 2nd

This day fair and with a fresh trade wind
ship under short sail and and steering
N. N. luff on S. tack fair night.
12-48 N.
