

June 7 Fresh winds ship under short sail all day and on port tack with a N. W. wind and a light swell

June 8th 31-38 N. Light winds with a swell partly overcast ship under short sail and by the wind on port tack

June 9th 31-39 N. This day calm ship under bare poles raise whales at about 9 am. lower boats and got 5 out of a school

June 10th 51-11 N. 31-38 N. Fine and smooth raise whale in early morning lower and got large whale along side and cut in 5 small ones chasing to leeward

June 11th 51-15 N. 31-21 N. Fine and smooth very light winds ship hauled back out in large whale in morning and lower in afternoon for school whales got none

June 12th 31-03 N. Strong wind from N. sailing under short sail two schooners in sight and both sailing

June 13th 51-19 N. 31-15 N. "Pedro Varela" and "Valparaiso" Fair and with moderate to light N.W. wind set all sail in morning put ship on N tack school in sight

June 14th 51-08 N. 31-25 N. Fine and smooth ship under full sail and on S.E. tack all day wind about S.E. were ship and shorten down at night. two school in sight.

June 15th 50-56 N. 31-45 N. N. winds raise school whales got 3 mate but his whale and then lost ship out all night ship aback with 3 whales blued weather a bit equally and three tiring during night.

June 16th No boats in sight mate and 3rd mate but since last night frigate up and cut in 2 whales and at 9:15 am. were ship set all sail with a good breeze and under all sail on port tack heading N.W. at noon raise small sail that turned out to be boats got boats on board at 8:30 P.M. after being out for 27 1/2 hours

June 17th This day fresh winds from N. N. W. ship under short sail until noon and on N tack and set all sail by the wind during afternoon

June 18th 51-54 N. 31-54 N. Fair and with a fresh winds from N. saw school of bulls going fast to wind no chance for boat stay down a couple of hours N. W. school lowered for same school 4 different school in sight

June 19th Overcast with fresh winds under short sail all day and on N tack with a partly wind back and center in sight

June 20th This day fair and with a light N.W. to N.E. wind ship under full sail and on S. tack until 4 P.M. and then tack S.W. and school in sight

July 1st 31-47 N. Fair and with light wind from N.E. under full sail and steering N.W. at night shorten down and lay on N tack game Margaret with 170 bbl of oil

July 2nd Fair and a bit hazy ship under full sail with light winds from N.W. steering N.W. to N. after 4 P.M. steer N.W. Margaret in sight
