Sun: Oct: 24th 1920

This day strong breeze & cloudy weather. Wind from NE. at 90 am set mainsail. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. pumps carefully attended every hour. End of day. no Lat: Sun obscure

Mon:

Oct: 25th 1920

This day strong breeze & clear. Wind from SE Close hauled. Saw steamer bound to NW. Watch employed repairing gib top sail. Hustled all up. Pump carefully attended every hour. a about 5 minute. End of day. no observation.

Tues:

Oct: 26th 1920

This day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Watch employed repairing port top sail. Pump carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 33-29 N.) (Lan: 46 43 W.)

Wed:

Oct: 27th 1920

This day fresh breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SE Close hauled. Watch employed in ship duty. Saw three steamers bound W. Lat: 34.97 N. Lan: 45.27 W.

Thurs: End of day.

Oct: 28th 1920

This day steady breeze & cloudy weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 35.35 N. Lan: 42.29 W.)

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Fri: Oct: 29th 1920

This day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Close hauled. Saw steamer bound W. Watch employed in ship duty. pumps carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 36.34 N.) (Lan: 43.26 W.)

Sat:

Oct: 30th 1920

This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Close hauled. Saw several steamers bound W. Watch employed painting boat & other duty. End of day. (Lat: 35.4-3 N.)

Sun:

Oct: 31st 1920 Lan: 43.42 W.

This day fresh breeze & clear weather. Wind from S all sails set. Course SE by E. at 430 p.m. Capt. saw some thing making white water to windward. Not make out what it was. at 5-30 take in on the light sails. End of day. (Lat: 35.45 N.)

Mon:

Oct: 1st 1920

This day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from S. all sails set. Course SE. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. pumps carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 35.52 N.)

Tues:

Oct: 2nd 1920

This day steady breeze & fine weather. Wind from S. Course SE all sails set. Saw several steamers & vessels bound W. Watch employed painting Boat & other duty. End of day. (Lat: 35.46 N.) (Lan: 37.26 W.)
