Thurs: Dec: 16th 1920

This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from S. Close hauled. Saw one sail & steamer. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 21.5°)

Fri:

Dec: 17th 1920

This day light breeze & squally with rain. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. no observation. (Lat: 30.58° W.)

Sat:

Dec: 18th 1920

This day light breeze & fine weather. Wind from S. Close hauled. at 6.30 a.m. Bargaining cartorio saw school of whales. Drove the boats but they went too fast to wind ~~and~~ don't get any. End of day. no observation. (Lat: 2.13° S.)

Sun:

Dec: 19th 1920

This day light breeze & fine weather. Wind from S. Close hauled. all sails set. at 3 p.m. were around on starboard tack. Saw nothing. End of day. (Lat: 2.13° S.)

Mon:

Dec: 20th 1920

This day steady breeze & fine weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 2.461° S.)

Tues:

Dec: 21st 1920

This day fresh breeze & clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. Pump carefully attended. End of day. (Lat: 4.648° S.)

Wed: Dec: 22nd 1920

This day fresh breeze & clear weather. all sails set. Saw nothing but one steamer. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 4.50° N.)

Thurs:

Dec: 23rd 1920

This day steady breeze & fine weather. all sails set. Close hauled wind from SSE. Island of ~~St.~~ Fernando & Naronha in sight a bout 10 miles to the N. of us. Saw two steamers bound S. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 4.08° S.)

Fri:

Dec: 24th 1920

This day fresh breeze & squally with rain. Wind from S. all sails set. Fernando & Naronha very near ship and go about. Wind from S. Saw steamer bound S. employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 3.23° S.)

Sat:

Dec: 25th 1920

This day light breeze & fine weather. Wind from S. at 6 p.m. wind halled to SE. Tack ship to the southward. Saw steamer bound S. Island of Fernando in sight. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 3.20° S.)

Sun:

Dec: 26th 1920

This day light breeze & fine weather. Wind from S. all sails set. Close hauled. Saw two steamers bound S. Island of St. Paul in sight. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 3.28° S.)
