Sun: April 17th 1921

This day steady Trade winds Clear weather. All sails set. Close hauled. at 3.30 p.m. Mate saw school of Whales drop down the boat but they went too fast - don't get any. End of day.

Lon: 65-55 W.

April 18th 1921

This day light Trade & fine clear weather. All sails set. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. Lat: 23.31 N.
Lon: 65-58 W.

Tues:

April 19th 1921

This day steady SE Wind & fine clear weather. All sails set. Course NE. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. Lat: 24.33 N.
Lon: 65-22 W.

Wed:

April 20th 1921

This day steady Wind from S. and clear weather. All sails set. Course SE by E. Saw sail board N. & saw a fin back. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. Lat: 25.40 N.
Lon: 64.33 W.

Thurs:

April 21st 1921

This day light breeze & squally with rain. All sails set. Close hauled. Saw sail board N. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. no observation

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Fri: April 22nd 1921

This day steady breeze & fine clear weather. All sails set. At 6.11 a.m. Mr. Ramon saw school of Whales drop down the boat. Third mate struck and came board got ready. Cutting the Whales & set sails. End of day. Lat: 26.32 N.
Lon: 64.17 W.

Sat:

April 23rd 1921

This day steady breeze & fine weather. All sails set. Saw sail board S. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. Lat: 27.30 N.
Lon: 64.25 W.

Sun:

April 24th 1921

This day light Trade & fine clear weather. All sails set. Close hauled. Saw nothing. Employed finish by end. Last night at 9 p.m. End of day. Lat: 28.33 N.
Lon: 63.54 W.

Mon:

April 25th 1921

This day light wind from S. All sail set. Course NE by E. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. Lat: 29.07 N.
Lon: 63.42 W.

Tues:

April 26th 1921

This day light breeze & fine clear weather. All sails set. Course NE. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. Lat: 29.12 N.
Lon: 63.15 W.

Wed:

April 27th 1921

This day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SW. Course NE. at 12.50 Jose & swarzes saw white water at 3.30 p.m. we saw the Whales drop the boat. Mate got 2. Second mate one third one.

Lat: 30.20 N.
Lon: 62.46 W.
