

Remarks on board Scho: Cameo master Luis Lopez.

Thurs: April 28th 1921

This day steady breeze & very cloudy with some rain. Wind from SW. Employed finish curing the whales and started to try out. Saw steamer bound W. End of day, no observation. Sun obscure.

Fri:

April 29th 1921

This day steady breeze & fine weather. Wind from SW. Lat 61.2. am John Perry from school of whales drop the boats. Third mate got one. Came board got ready getting the whale & sent down the gears. Set watch. End of day. Lat: 30.5-3 N. (Lani 6159 W.) WP

Sat:

April 30th 1921

This day steady breeze & fine weather. Employed finish try out at 3 p.m. Jose Surres, saw school of whales drop down the boats. Third mate got one. Small whale. Saw steamer bound W. End of day. Lat: 31.1 N. (Lani 6140 W.) WP

Sun:

May 1st 1921

This day fresh breeze & very cloudy. Wind from SW. Employed finish curing the whale. Mate sails & started to try out. At 11:50 p.m. we saw a white water long ways off from for it but was too late to stop. Mate got what it was. End of day. Lat: 31.27 N. (Lani 6115 W.)

Remarks on board Scho: Cameo master L. Lopez.

Mon: May 2nd 1921

This day strong breeze & cloudy. Wind from SW. Ship running on small sails to eastward. Saw nothing. Employed pump out some salt water getting ready to put oil in. End of day. (Lat: 31.17 N. Lani 6002 W.)

Tues:

May 3rd 1921

This day strong breeze & high seas. Ship on small sails. Saw sail bound to the steamer to westward. Employed stowed down some oil 183 barrel. End of day. Lat: 31.04 N. (Lani 5936 W.)

Wed:

May 4th 1921

This day light breeze & smooth at 6 a.m. Antonio Antonio saw school of whales drop down the boats. Mate got one. Came board curing the whale and sent down the gears. Weather getting very squally with heavy rain all day. Antonio Antonio missed whale 3 times for Mate so Captain put him out from mate boat and give him a charge of B.B. So put John Perry in mate boat. John got sick with pain blue ball & Charles so put out of the boiler on mate boat & got the whale. Capt. off him 5 dollars for every whale he got. End of day. no observation. (Lani 5811 W.)

Thurs:

May 5th 1921

This day fresh breeze & high seas. Very cloudy. Wind from SW. Ship on small sails. Employed try out. Saw nothing. End of day. no observation.
