Wed: July 6th 1921

p.m. This day fresh breeze & clear weather. Wind from SE. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 34.16 N.) (Lon: 45-23 W.)

Thurs.

July 7th 1921

p.m. This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. all sails set. Saw some black fish. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 34.06 N.) (Lon: 44.48 W.)

Fri.

July 8th 1921

p.m. This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from N. all sails set. At 3-25 a.m. Manuel Brito saw school of whales drop down the boat. Mate got one second mate one third mate one came board got ready cutting the three whales & sent the gears down got supper at 10 p.m. End of day. (Lat: 33.55 N.) (Lon: 44.14 W.)

Sat.

July 9th 1921

p.m. This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from NE all sails set. Employed tryant. At 5 p.m. Manuel Brito saw school of whales drop down the boat but they was going too fast. Came back. End of day. (Lat: 33.40 N.) (Lon: 44.36 W.)



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Sun: July 10th 1921

p.m. This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Employed tryant. Saw some black head grampas though was whales drop the boat. Spent out it was grampas. Saw two steamers bound W. End of day. (Lat: 33.30 N.) (Lon: 45-27 W.)

Mon:

July 11th 1921

p.m. This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from SE all sails set. Watch employed finish tryant and stowed down 47 barrel of oil. Saw nothing. End of day. (Lat: 33.26 N.) (Lon: 45.43 W.)

Tues:

July 12th 1921

p.m. This light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind hall to SE. all sails set. At 11.15 Mate saw school of whales drop down the boat. Mate got one B. Boat got one came board got everything ready for the morning start. End of day. (Lat: 33.34 N.) (Lon: 47.14 W.)

Wed:

July 13th 1921

p.m. This day calm & clear weather. Employed cutting the whales & started to tryant. Saw nothing. End of day. (Lat: 33.41 N.) (Lon: 46.59 W.)

Thurs.

July 14th 1921

p.m. This day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. all sails set. Close hauled. Employed finish tryant. Saw lots of paper & grampas. End of day.
