Fri. July 15th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. Saw nothing. Employed stowed down some oil 58 barrel. End of day. (Lat: 33.37 N.) (Lon: 47.22 W.)

Sat:

July 16th. 1921

p.m. this light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. Saw Whaling Schooner to the S. of us trying out. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 34.56 N.) (Lon: 47.31 W.)

Sun:

July 17th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. Saw Whaling Schooner with all sails outboard to W. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 32.43 N.) (Lon: 47.50 W.)

Mon:

July 18th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 32.48 N.) (Lon: 48.35 W.)

Tues:

July 19th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. Saw sail to the S.W. of us. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 33.08 N.) (Lon: 49.03 W.)

Wed:

July 20th. 1921

p.m. this day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from E. All sails set. Saw sail bound W. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 33.40 N.) (Lon: 49.43 W.)

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Thurs. July 21st. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from E. All sails set. Saw nothing. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 33.55 N.) (Lon: 49.39 W.)

Fri.

July 22nd. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from E. All sails set. Saw Steamer bound W. pick up a Spar with lots small fish in it. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 33.38 N.) (Lon: 50.19 W.)

Sat:

July 23rd. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from E. Ship running to westward under small sails. pick up a log & cut lots fish. End of day. (Lat: 33.28 N.) (Lon: 50.33 W.)

Sun:

July 24th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from E. All sails set. Saw Steamer bound W. also Whaling Schooner have three boats down long ways off. End of day. (Lat: 33.32 N.) (Lon: 50.48 W.)

Mon:

July 25th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. At 8:30 a.m. Whaling Schooner saw Whales drop her boat, got whales & we drop our boats. Whales came to our line we got one large cow & small calf. Third mate. Came board got ready cutting & make spilt. Saw Steamer bound W. End of day. (Lat: 33.55 N.) (Lon: 50.43 W.)
