

Remarks on board Scho: Canuo Master Luis Lopez.

Tues: July 26th 1921

p.m. this day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from NW. All sails set. Employed finish tryant saw nothing. Schooner W. Graber in sight cutting the whale. End of day. (Lat: 33.49 N.) (Lon: 50.42 W.)

Wed:

July 27th 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from NW. All sails set. Saw nothing but Schooner Graber trying out. Watch employed in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 33.24 N.) (Lon: 50.50 W.)

Thurs:

July 28th 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from NW. All sails set. Saw bark Wondrer & gave her at 7 a.m. we saw a school of whales drop the boat mate got one & can mate one third mate got one bark got two came aboard cutting & set sails. End of day. (Lat: 33.09 N.) (Lon: 51.10 W.)

Fri:

July 29th 1921

p.m. this day calm all day and clear weather. Saw large white water but it was too far to not make out what it was. Barque Wondrer saw whales had 4 boats down. Saw a rather schooner to the S. of us. Watch employed trying out. End of day. (Lat: 33.06 N.) (Lon: 50.4 W.)

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Sat: July 30th 1921

p.m. this day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from NW. All sails set. Employed stowed down all 45-bars. Saw Schooner Margaret trying out. Saw Graber & gave her also bark Wondrer in sight. She have 670 Margaret 300 Graber 440 End of day. (Lat: 33.29 N.) (Lon: 51.04 W.)

Sun:

July 31st 1921

p.m. this day steady breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from NW. All sails set. At 2:25 p.m. we saw a large whale going to windward very fast. We do not lower the boat. Bark Wondrer drop her boats but not get it. End of day. (Lat: 33.09 N.) (Lon: 50.24 W.)

Mon:

Aug 1st 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & squally wind from W. All sails set. Saw three sails & steamer Schooner Margaret spoke to the steamer got the longitude from him and I went aboard Margaret & find out my chronometer was out 52 miles. Saw Scho: Graber cutting whale. End of day. (Lat: 33.15 N.) (Lon: 49.44 W.)

Tues:

Aug 2nd 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine clear weather. Wind from W. All sails set. Saw three vessel bark Wondrer trying out Schooner Margaret got whale. Scho: Graber cutting whale. End of day. (Lat: 33.01 N.) (Lon: 49.22 W.)
