with rain. Wind from E. Ship running
to westward on the small sails.
Saw some grampses. Watch employed
in ship duty. End of day. (Lat: 32.53 N.)

Wed.

Aug. 10th. 1921

p.m. this day began with fresh
breeze & squally with rain at p.m.
do weather wind from E. all sails
set. Saw one schooner cutting
whale. Watch employed in ship duty.
End of day. (Lat: 32.43 N.)
(Lon: 51.44 W.)

Thurs.

Aug. 11th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine
clear weather. Wind from E. all
sails set. Saw nothing. Still at
p.m. Watch employed in ship
duty. End of day. (Lat: 33.21 N.)
(Lon: 51.39 W.)

Fri.

Aug. 12th. 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine
clear weather. Wind from E. all sails
set. Saw two steamers bound E.
Watch employed in ship duty.
End of day. (Lat: 33.25 N.)
