

Remarks on board Scho: Camoo Master L. Lopez.

Sat Aug. 13th: 1921

p.m. this day Calm & Clear weather.
Saw Steamer bound W. Watch
Employed in ship duty. End of day.

Sun:

Aug. 14th: 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine
Clear weather. Wind from NW. all
Sails set at 2:15 p.m. off port
with French Steamer *Ulysses*
Amsterdam got *Saugetub* from
her. Watch employed in ship duty.
End of day.

Mon:

Aug. 15th: 1921

p.m. this day Calm & Clear weather
at 9 a.m. Antonio Antonio saw
School of Whales drop down the
boats mate got one second mate
one third mate struck one
lost it. B. Boat got one. Same
board got ready cutting the
Whales & sent down the gears.
Set watch. End of day.

Tues:

Aug. 16th: 1921

p.m. this day light breeze & fine
Clear weather. Wind from NW.
all Sails set. Employed by out
Saw Schooner *Margaret*.
End of day.

Wed: Aug. 17th: 1921

p.m. this day Calm & Clear weather.
Employed finish tryout & stowed
down some oil in barrel. Game with
Schooner *Margaret* at 4:55 p.m.
Antonio Antonio saw School of Whales
drop down the boats Camoo second
mate got one. *Margaret* second mate
got one boat got a long side at
2 a.m. End of day.

Thurs:

Aug. 18th: 1921

p.m. this day began with light breeze
and fine Clear weather. Wind from SW.
all Sails set. Employed Captain & one
boat crew went aboard *Margaret*
helping cutting the Whales. Saw nothing
End of day.

Fri:

Aug. 19th: 1921

p.m. this day steady breeze & fine
weather at 6 a.m. observed *Brito*
saw School of Whales drop the
boats mate got one third mate
struck one take his boat under
water second mate struck it
again. Came aboard got ready cutting
the Whales & mate Sails Schooner
Grabe in side saw Steamer bound
W. End of day. no observation

Sat:

Aug. 20th: 1921

p.m. this day steady breeze & fine clear
weather with from SW all Sails set at
6 a.m. we saw School of Whales with
Scho: Grabe & *Margaret* chop boats Grabe
got one only at 6 p.m. gaming with *Margaret*
Employed tryout End of day.
