

Friday August 2nd

Lat 38° 22' N Long 74° 06' W Breeze began with light rain squalls all this day. The ship heading to S. S. E. until 6 P. M. when it was to N. N. E. The light sails in and the fore top sail double reefed. The heading to N. N. E. The middle and latter parts, several sails in sight. One man off duty sick. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day.

Saturday August 3rd

Lat 40° 10' N Long 74° 4' W Pleasant all this day with a fresh breeze from N. E. The first and middle parts. The latter part a light breeze from the same quarter turned out the reefs and set main S. S. sail and fly jib. The ship steered by the wind and heading to N. E. E. All day. Several sails in sight. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds.

Sunday August 4th

Lat 40° 45' N Long 74° 40' W Fine weather all this day with light airs from E. The ship heading to N. N. E. The first part the middle part calm. The latter part light airs from N. E. Course E. N. E. All sail out several sails in sight and so ends this day.

Monday August 5th

Lat 42° 10' N Long 74° 45' W Fine weather the first and middle parts of this day with light airs from N. E. N. The ship heading to E. N. E. The latter part rainy with light variable winds. The ship heading in all directions. Several sails in sight. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day.

Tuesday August 6th

Lat 41° 33' N Long 74° 41' W Cloudy the first with light breezes from N. E. The ship heading to N. E. 1/2 S. The latter part from N. Rhodes going quick to windward, lowered for them but they soon went out of sight. The middle part calm. The latter part light breezes from N. E. Course N. E. All sail out several sails in sight. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds this day.

Wednesday August 7th

Lat 42° 10' N Long 74° 41' W Pleasant the first part with light airs from N. E. The ship heading to N. E. The middle part calm and rainy. The latter part light breezes from N. E. Course E. All day under short sail. Several sails in sight. The watch employed in ships duty and so ends this day.

Thursday August 8th

Lat 42° 22' N Long 74° 51' W Clear weather all this day with light variable winds and calms. The ship heading from S. by S. to E. N. E. Several sails in sight, saw fin backs. The watch employed in making spinnaker and so ends this day.

Friday August 9th

Lat 43° 43' N Long 74° 51' W The first part cloudy with light breeze from N. E. Course E. N. E. The middle and latter parts squally and rainy with fresh breezes from N. E. N. The ship heading from N. E. by S. to E. by N. under short sail. Two sails in sight and so ends this day.

Saturday August 10th

Lat 45° 34' N Long 74° 51' W Cloudy and rainy the first and middle parts with a strong breeze from N. E. N. The ship heading to N. E. by E. under double reefed top sails. The latter part clear weather with strong breezes from N. E. N. Course E. N. E. Several sails in sight. The watch employed in making spinnaker. And so ends this day.

Sunday August 11th

Lat 45° 16' N Long 74° 51' W Squally all this day with strong breezes from N. E. N. The first and middle parts the ship under double reefed top sails and heading to N. E. by E. all day. The latter part more moderate. Turned the reefs out of the main topsail. A number of sails in sight and so ends this day.

Monday August 12th

Lat 45° 00' N Long 74° 51' W Clear weather all this day with fresh breezes from N. E. N. The ship under short sail and heading to E. N. E. All day. The watch employed in ships duty, board sails in sight, saw fin backs and so ends this day.

Tuesday August 13th

Clear weather all this day with light breezes from N. E. N. The ship steered by the wind and heading to E. N. E. All day under cruising sail. Several sails in sight and so ends this day.
