 with a good breeze from N.E. & course S.E. The first part of the day
 the middle and the latter part all sail out the stages
 of the continent & Wilsons in sight the latter part and
 so ends

Monday September 23rd
 Lat 16° 05' N Long 23° 38' W Fine weather all this day
 with a good breeze from N.E. & course S.E. The ship
 towed the main yard aback at 8 A.M. kept off to S. again at 11 A.M.
 light the Island of Brava in sight ahead at 4 P.M. The Captain went
 on shore the remainder of the day the ship off and on and so
 ends

Tuesday September 24th
 Fine weather all this day with light breeze from
 N.E. & E. The ship off and on at Brava. Got off a number of hogs
 the first part the latter part about on shore after to third
 Mate and so ends

Wednesday September 25th
 No Obs. Fine weather all this day with light breeze from
 N. and N.E. The ship off and on at Brava until 2 P.M. Got
 down by the main of George Costa to go on this a Mate and promoted
 Mr. Peterson from Third Mate to Acting Second Mate at 3 P.M.
 kept off to S. by W. All drawing sails set and so ends

Thursday September 26th
 Lat 13° 48' N Long 24° 43' W Fine weather all this day
 with calms and light breeze from N. and N.E. & course S.E. & W. All
 drawing sails set at 4 P.M. saw black fish, lowered for them but got
 none, And so ends.

Friday September 27th
 Lat 13° 04' N Long 25° 09' W Fine weather all this
 day with light breeze from N.E. & E. & S.W. & course S.E. & W. and
 S.W. All drawing sails set. Several sails in sight, And
 so ends

Saturday September 28th
 Lat 11° 00' N Long 24° 43' W Fine weather all this day with
 light breeze from N.E. & E. & course S.E. & W. All day all sail out
 Several sails in sight the watch employed in ship's duty
 and so ends this day

Sunday September 29th
 Lat 8° 35' N Long 24° 26' W Fine weather the first
 part with light breeze from N.E. & course S.E. & W. the middle and
 latter part squally with rain and variable winds and calms the ship
 heading to S.E. & W. spoke the ship, C.C. South East of Richmond from
 Liverpool bound to Calcutta, several other sails in sight and so
 ends

Monday September 30th
 Squally and rainy all this day with light winds
 from all quarters, course S.E. & W. A number of sails in sight
 the watch employed in catching water and so ends this day

Tuesday October 1st
 No Obs. Mainly the first part the middle and
 latter part squally the wind light most of the time and
 from S.E. & W. the ship steered by the wind and on both tacks.
 during the day a number of sails in sight and so ends

Wednesday October 2nd
 Lat 2° 25' N Long 25° 25' W Fine weather all this day
 with light breeze from N.E. & E. the ship steered by the wind and
 heading from S.E. to S. several sails in sight and so ends

Thursday October 3rd
 Lat 3° 43' N Long 25° 49' W Fine weather the first
 and middle parts. The latter part rainy the wind light and
 variable the ship heading from S.E. to S. by W. and on both
 tacks during the day a number of sails in sight and so ends

Friday October 4th
 Lat 4° 53' N Long 25° 49' W Cloudy most of the day
 with a little rain and a fresh breeze from N.E. & W. Most of the time
 the ship steered by the wind and heading from S.E. by W. to
 S. & E. several sails in sight and so ends.

Saturday October 5th
 Lat 5° 30' N Long 25° 49' W Breeze weather most of
 the day with fresh breeze from N.E. & W. the ship steered by the
 wind and on both tacks during the day and heading from S.E.
 to W. several sails in sight and so ends
