

Sunday October 6<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 23° 10' N Long 22° 27' W Fine weather all the day  
with a fresh breeze from S. by E. The ship steered by the  
wind and heading from N. by E. to N. by S. several sails in sight  
and sounds

Monday October 7<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 12° 23' N Long 22° 43' W Fine weather all the  
day with a good breeze from S. E. courses N. by S. all day till  
sail out. The watch employed the latter part in breaking out  
bread and flour and cooping it. Several sails in sight and sounds

Tuesday October 8<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 1° 14' S Long 22° 03' W Fine weather the first and  
latter parts. The middle part squally. Courses N. by S. with  
strong S. E. trades. Several sails in sight. Saw blackfish and  
sounds

Wednesday October 9<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 4° 06' S Long 22° 29' W Fine weather all the day with  
the exception of a squall in the first part. Courses N. by E. S. E.  
all day with fresh S. E. trades. Several sails in sight. The latter  
part the watch employed in cooping bread and flour and sounds

Thursday October 10<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 7° 03' S Long 22° 58' W Fine weather all the day  
with fresh S. E. trades. Courses N. by E. S. E. all day till sail out  
one sail in sight. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds

Friday October 11<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 10° 14' S Long 23° 06' W Fine weather all the  
day with fresh breezes from N. E. S. E. courses N. by E. S. E. all day  
all sail out. The watch employed in ships duty and sounds

Saturday October 12<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 13° 13' S Long 23° 41' W Fine weather all the day  
with fresh breezes from N. E. S. E. to N. E. courses N. by E. S. E. all day  
sail out. And sounds

Sunday October 13<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 18° 44' S Long 24° 20' W Fine weather the first and  
middle parts with a fresh breeze from N. courses S. E. several sails in  
sight. The latter part heavy squall and rain and wind from all quarters  
double reefed and manded main sail jib and spanker. And sounds

Monday October 14<sup>th</sup>  
No Obstr. Cloudy all the day with light variable winds and  
in the first part the middle and latter parts light breezes from  
S. E. S. W. ship heading to S. N. E. all sail out. the sails in sight  
and sounds

Tuesday October 15<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 19° 00' S Long 24° 17' W Clear most of the day with  
fresh breezes from S. E. S. W. The ship steered by the wind and  
heading from S. N. E. to N. by E. All sail out. One sail in sight  
and sounds

Wednesday October 16<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 18° 16' S Long 24° 17' W Clear weather all the day  
with fresh breezes from S. E. S. W. The ship steered by the wind  
and heading to S. N. E. One sail in sight. The watch employed  
in ships duty and sounds

Thursday October 17<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 19° 00' S Long 24° 17' W Fine weather all the day with  
a fresh breeze from S. E. S. W. The ship steered by the wind the first and  
middle parts and heading to S. N. E. The latter part courses by  
N. One sail in sight and sounds

Friday October 18<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 22° 33' S Long 24° 17' W Fine weather the first  
part. Light breeze from S. E. S. W. to S. E. S. W. The middle part  
fresh breezes from N. The latter part strong breezes from the same  
quarter. Courses by N. all day under easy sail and sounds

Saturday October 19<sup>th</sup>  
No Obstr. Thick and hazy with fresh breezes from N. E. S. W.  
The first part the ship under short sail course S. N. E. The middle part  
more moderate. The latter part with strong breezes from N. E. S. W.  
The ship heading to S. by the wind and sounds

Sunday October 20<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 23° 37' S Long 24° 20' W Clear weather most of the day  
with strong breezes from S. W. The ship steered by the wind and  
on both tops during the day under double reefed top sails. One sail  
in sight and sounds
