

Friday November 15th
No other clouds the first part the middle and
latter parts clear with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. The
ship heading from S.W. to S.E. and so ends, Sun back around

Saturday November 16th
Lat 39° 08' Long 87° 36' W. Clear weather all this day
with strong breezes from N.W. to S.W. The first part double reefed and
hauled the main sail the ship to S.W. The middle part fresh
breezes from S.W. to S.E. the latter part light breezes from
the same quarter. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks
during the time, Sun back around and so ends

Sunday November 17th
Lat 39° 40' Long 87° 13' W. Clear weather the first part
with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. the middle and latter part a good
breeze from the same quarter. The weather smoky, course S.W. till
day. And so ends

Monday November 18th
Lat 41° 12' Long 84° 25' W. Clear weather most of
this day with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. The first part
the middle part strong breezes from N.W. to S.W. the latter part
light breezes. The ship heading from N.W. to S.W. and under
double reefed top sails part of the time. Plenty of fin backs
around, and so ends

Tuesday November 19th
Lat 45° 10' Long 82° 14' W. Smoky all the day
with fresh breezes the first and middle parts, double reefed the
top sails the latter part light breezes. Made sail. The wind variable
from S.W. to N.W. to S.W. The ship heading from N.W. to S.W.
And so ends

Wednesday November 20th
Lat 45° 10' Long 84° 44' W. Clear weather all the day with
breezes from N.W. to S.W. The ship heading from N.W. to S.W. One sail
in sight and so ends

Thursday November 21st
Lat 46° 36' Long 86° 44' W. Clear weather all this day
with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. The ship heading from
S.W. to S.E. and under double reefed top sails part of the time
and so ends

Friday November 22nd
Lat 45° 58' Long 88° 54' W. Clear weather most of this day
with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. The ship heading from N.W. to S.W.
and under double reefed top sails part of the time. Sun back
around and so ends

Saturday November 23rd
Lat 49° 16' Long 89° 54' W. Clear weather all this day with
fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. The ship heading from N.W. to S.W.
of the time N.W. Backland Islands in sight to the S.E. some distance
and so ends

Sunday November 24th
No other clouds commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W.
The ship heading to S.W. by the wind. At 3 P.M. fresh N.W. and double
reefed and hauled the courses. The North Backland in sight to the S.W.
The wind hauled to S.W. and moderated and headed to S.W. by S.
The latter part light breezes from N.W. with fog and rain across S.W. till
trailing sails set, and so ends

Monday November 25th
No other clouds weather with a drizzling rain and a fresh
breeze from N.W. to S.W. The first and middle parts the ship on both
tacks during the time and heading from N.W. to S.W. and under double
reefed top sails part of the time. The latter part clear weather with light
breezes from N.W. to S.W. One sail in sight and so ends

Tuesday November 26th
Lat 51° 33' Long 86° 36' W. Clear weather the first part course S.
with a good breeze from N.W. The middle and part of the latter part fog with
a fresh breeze from N.W. Middle part changed the light sails the latter
part light breeze from N.W. to S.W. and so ends

Wednesday November 27th
Lat 54° 09' Long 87° 04' W. Clear weather to day blazes
Rain calm and light breeze all equal and a double reefed top sail brought
land in sight to the S.W. the first part 11 miles distant. The wind from
N.W. first and middle parts the ship heading from S.W. to S.E. the latter part
Shaving hauled for N.W. the ship heading to the southward under short
sail. And so ends. And del. Linn again in sight
