

Thursday November 28th
Lat 38° 51' Long 124° 41' W. The first part of this day clear weather with fresh breezes from N.W. The ship heading to S.W. by S. The middle part squally with strong breezes the ship under sport sail heading from S.W. to S. The latter part strong breezes from S.W. the ship covered by the wind and on both tacks during the time under short sail. One sail in sight and no ends.

Friday November 29th
Lat 38° 45' Long 125° 58' W. Squally all this day with strong breezes from N.W. to S.W. The ship heading to S.W. by S. The middle and latter parts by the wind on both tacks during the time all possible sail out. Several sails in sight and no ends.

Saturday November 30th
Lat 38° 10' Long 126° 48' W. Equally all this day with fresh breezes from S.W. the ship heading to S.W. by the wind all possible sail out. Several sails in sight and no ends.

Sunday December 1st
Lat 36° 13' Long 127° 15' W. Equally the first part middle parts with strong breezes from S.W. The ship heading from S.W. by N. to N.W. all possible sail, out several sails in sight. The latter part calm and light airs from N.W. to S.W. the ship heading to S.W. by N. all sail out. One sail in sight and no ends this day.

Monday December 2nd
Lat 35° 50' Long 128° 22' W. Clear weather most of this day with light breezes from N.W. to N. course S.W. by N. the first and middle parts calm and light airs from N.W. to S.W. the latter part calm and a number of sails in sight and no ends.

Tuesday December 3rd
Lat 35° 48' Long 129° 58' W. Clear weather the first part with light breezes from N. course S.W. by N. Diego, Camero, and other islands in sight. All several sails. The middle part squally with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. the ship heading S.W. by N. the latter part quite clear with fresh breezes from N. course S.W. by N. all possible sail out and no ends.

Wednesday December 4th
Lat 35° 30' Long 131° 41' W. Equally all this day, some of the squalls very heavy. With strong breezes from N.W. the first and middle parts to the latter part fresh gales from the same quarter. Course N.W. by N. all possible sail out. One sail in sight and no ends.

Thursday December 5th
Lat 35° 17' Long 132° 48' W. Fresh gales the first part from N.W. by N. with heavy snow squalls. The ship now to heading to S.W. by N. The middle part moderate with fresh breezes from N.W. by S. The latter part calm with light airs from N.W. to S.W. The ship heading to the southward by the wind all sail out. One sail in sight and no ends.

Friday December 6th
Lat 35° 00' Long 134° 47' W. Equally the first part with fresh breezes from N.W. The ship heading to southward by the wind under double reefed. The middle and latter part quite pleasant with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. by N. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the time. One sail in sight and no ends.

Saturday December 7th
No Ob. Equally the first and middle parts with fresh breezes from N.W. to S.W. by N. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the time heading from S.W. to S.W. by N. One sail in sight. The latter part calm and no ends.

Sunday December 8th
Lat 35° 50' Long 135° 58' W. The first part calm and light airs from N.W. The middle and latter parts light breezes from S.W. course S.W. by N. drawing sails set. One sail in sight. Heavy of thin backs around and no ends.

Monday December 9th
Lat 35° 20' Long 137° 58' W. Clear weather all this day with calm and light airs from S.W. course N.W. by N. The first and middle and latter parts all drawing sails set. One sail in sight and no ends.

Tuesday December 10th
Lat 35° 15' Long 138° 58' W. Fine weather all this day with calm and light airs from calm and light airs from S.W. course N.W. by N. The sails in sight and no ends.
