

Monday May 4th

Lat 2° 10' N Long 140° 32' W Fine weather all the day with light breezes from S.W. The first and middle parts. The latter part a fresh breeze from N. and E. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the first and middle parts. The latter part, caused by duty.

Tuesday May 5th

Lat 2° 45' N Long 139° 56' W Cloudy all the day with fresh breezes from N. & E. The first and middle parts. The latter part strong breeze from the same quarter. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the day.

Wednesday May 6th

Lat 2° 19' N Long 140° 00' W Light breezes from S.W. to E. The ship heading E. & S. at 8 A.M. split the main sail. dued it up and sent it down at sunset hauled the courses. The middle and latter parts rainy. The ship now under easy sail and sends.

Thursday May 7th

No Obey. Fine weather. The first part with strong breezes from S.W. The ship heading E. The middle and latter parts fine weather. caused by E. with light breeze from S.W. The watch employed in repairing the main top sail. And sends.

Friday May 8th

Lat 2° 44' N Long 140° 48' W Fine weather most of the day with light breezes from S.W. to E. & S. Finished repairs on the main top sail and bent it. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the day.

Saturday May 9th

Lat 2° 51' N Long 141° 11' W Fine weather all the day with light variable winds. The Bonin Islands in sight. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the day. The Blacksmith drew a new iron on the second mate, Placed him in irons and put him in the run.

Sunday May 10th

Lat 2° 10' N Long 141° 50' W Fine weather. The first part the middle and latter parts rainy. The wind light and variable. The ship heading in various directions during the day. Bonin Islands in sight. released the Blacksmith and sent him to duty.

Monday May 11th

No Obey. Raining all the day with light variable winds. The ship heading various courses during the day. One of the Sulphur Islands in sight and sends.

Tuesday May 12th

No Obey. Raining the first part with rain and variable. The ship heading E. & S. The middle part calm. The latter part fine weather with light breezes from S.W. & E. The ship steered by the wind and heading E. & S. Bonin Islands in sight. And sends.

Wednesday May 13th

No Obey. Fine weather all the day with light breezes from S.W. & E. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the day. At 10 A.M. saw humpbacks leaved and chased them. Baley's Island in sight to the N. E. 20 miles.

Thursday May 14th

No Obey. Fine weather all the day with light breezes from S.W. & E. The ship steered various courses during the day. Baley's Island in sight. The second mate and another man off duty sick and sends.

Friday May 15th

Lat 2° 28' N Long 142° 18' W Fine weather all the day with light breezes from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and on both tacks during the day. Baley's Island in sight. And sends.

Saturday May 16th

No Obey. Fine weather all the day with light breezes from S.W. & E. The Bonin Islands in sight the first part. The ship steered various courses during the day. A number of Finbacks. The latter part one of the Sulphur Islands in sight. And sends.
