Sunday June 14<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. & E. The first and middle parts the latter part calm. The ship heading N.W. by the wind. One sail in sight. And so ends

Monday June 15<sup>th</sup>

Left 26 00 N. Longitude 142 00 E. Clear weather and a calm all this day. Had a gam with the Janus. The watch employed in ship's duty. And so ends

Tuesday June 16<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day with light airs from S.E. & E. The ship heading from S. to N.W. The Bonin Islands in sight to the N. The Janus in company. And so ends. placed irons on John Lougee for flogging

Wednesday June 17<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. & E. The ship steered by the wind. The first and middle parts the latter part course N.W. Bonin Islands in sight. And so ends. took the man out of irons sent him to duty

Thursday June 18<sup>th</sup>

Left 26 55 N. Longitude 142 00 E. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. The ship cruising Bonin Islands to the west 25 miles. The Janus in company. And so ends

Friday June 19<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day. The ship cruising Bonin Islands to the west 20 miles. Had a gam rained in irons for flogging. And so ends

Saturday June 20<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from E. The ship heading a number of courses the first and middle parts the latter part course N.W. by the wind. One sail in sight to the N. sent Manuel Bamer to duty. And so ends

Sunday June 21<sup>st</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from S. spoke and gamed with the Janus. The ship cruising off the east side of the Bonin Islands. And so ends

Monday June 22<sup>nd</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from S. The ship cruising off and on the east side of the Bonin Islands. The Janus in company. The main mate off duty sick and so ends

Tuesday June 23<sup>rd</sup>

No Obert. Fine weather the first and middle parts with light breezes from S.E. & E. The Bonin Islands in sight to the N. spoke the Janus. The latter part smoky with fresh breezes from S.E. & E. split the fly jib in a gale, repaired and bent it again. And so ends

Wednesday June 24<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine and smoky all this day with fresh breezes from S.E. & E. and a heavy swell from S.W. The ship cruising off and on the Bonin Islands. under easy sail. And so ends

Thursday June 25<sup>th</sup>

No Obert. Fine and smoky all this day with fresh breezes from S.E. & E. The ship cruising off the Bonin Islands. The Janus in sight. Found that the main top mast was in a very bad state hauled out the new one and commenced fitting it. And so ends

Friday June 26<sup>th</sup>

The weather the same as yesterday with a strong breeze from S. spoke the Janus. The ship cruising to the E of Ogasawara Island the first and middle parts the latter part course N.W. The Janus in company. And so ends
