Tuesday July 14th
No Obv. Fine weather all this day with light airs from S.W. The ship cruising between the rock and St. Peter's. Finished boiling at 9 A.M. and cleared up decks. Spoke the janus and got 3 fags from her And sounds

Wednesday July 15th
No Obv. Fine weather all this day with light airs from S. The ship steered by the wind and on one tack. Took during the day cruising between the rock and St. Peter's two sails in sight And sounds

Thursday July 16th
No Obv. Fine weather with light airs from S.W. The ship cruising between the rock and land of St. Peter's. Spoke the janus and Calce. Whaling to leeward. Found our broad gun set, but no change for a whale. The latter part all hands employed in breaking out to stow down And sounds

Friday July 17th
No Obv. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from S. The ship cruising between the rock and St. Peter's two sails in sight. The latter part all hands employed in stowing down oil And sounds

Saturday July 18th
No Obv. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from S. The ship cruising between the rock and St. Peter's two sails in sight And sounds
