Lat 32 10 N Long 154 27 E Strong breeze the first
part and the weather clearing. A very heavy swell from
the wind. Ship heading E. At sun set double reefed and
handed handed all others but the storm stay sails. At 4
A. M. wore ship the wind hauling to Eastward. And blowing
hard. Barometer 29.10 At 8 A. M. called all hands and handed
the top sails sent down top gallant yards turned up leech
and made all snug for dry footing. Blowing hard and a big swell
on. The latter part the wind backed to N. E. and more
moderate. Barometer rising and so ends

Thursday August 20th
Lat 32 20 N Long 154 28 E Clear weather all this
day with fresh breeze from N. E. to N. W. The ship have
to heading to Eastward. The middle and latter parts
strong breeze from N. W. Course N. by E under double
reefed top sails. sent top gallant yards aloft. The janus in
sight. And so ends

Friday August 21st
No Obst. Clear weather all this day with the
exceptions of a few light rain squalls. The wind from N. E. to
the first part. Course N. by E. The middle part calm. The
latter part a good breeze from E. Course E. And so ends

Saturday August 22nd
Lat 32 25 N Long 154 25 E Fine weather all this day
with fresh breeze from N. The ship heading to E. S. E. The first
and middle parts. The latter part course N. E. by E. The janus
in company. And so ends

Sunday August 23rd
Lat 32 08 N Long 154 20 E Clear weather all this day
with fresh breeze from N. The first and middle parts the ship
heading to the eastward. The latter part calm and light airs
from E. Course N. E. The janus in company. And so ends

Monday August 24th
Lat 32 30 N Long 154 30 E Squally with light breeze
from N. E. The first part. The ship heading to E. The janus
the middle and latter parts. Strong breeze from E. with squalls
The ship heading to E. Under double reefed top sails. And so ends

Tuesday August 25th
No Obst. Smoky weather all this day with strong
breeze from N. The ship heading to E. All day under sail and
the janus in company. And so ends

Wednesday August 26th
Lat 33 15 N Long 154 23 E Cloudy and smoky
weather all this day with fresh breeze from E. Course. Call
day the janus in company. Land seen back. And so ends

Thursday August 27th
Lat 33 30 N Long 154 08 E Cloudy most of this day
with a few rain squalls and a fresh breeze from E to S. W. Course
the first part. Spoke the janus. The middle part to E. S. E.
by the wind. The latter part course N. And so ends

Friday August 28th
No Obst. Pleasant weather all this day with moderate
breeze from N. E. The ship heading to N. E. The first part and
N. E. The middle part and E. The latter part and cruising sail
The watch employed in cleaning iron work. And so ends

Saturday August 29th
Lat 34 40 N Long 154 03 E The first part pleasant
with light breeze from N. Course E. by E. The watch employed
in painting gun work. The middle part rain with light
airs from E. Ship heading to E. The latter part calm and
light breeze from N. with rain. Ship heading to E. S. E. And
so ends

Sunday 30th August 30th
Lat 34 50 N Long 150 30 E Fresh breeze all this day
from N. E. with a little rain the first part. The middle and
latter parts clear. Spoke the janus. The ship heading to
E and E. S. E. all day. And so ends

Monday August 31st
Lat 33 52 N Long 151 54 E Clear weather most
of this day with strong breeze from N. E. The ship heading
to E. S. E. by the wind under double reefed top sails. The
watch employed in cleaning iron work. And so ends
