Friday November 27th
Lat 19 00 N Long 106 50 W Fine weather all this
day with a fine breeze from N. Course S.E. All possible
sail out all hands employed in breaking out oil Cooper
and storing back found a number of bad casks.
End so ends.

Saturday November 28th
Lat 19 07 N Long 106 03 W Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from N. to N.E. Course
S.E. All drawing sails set. The first part the watch
employed in washing ship to paint the latter part painting
ship in board and so ends.

Sunday November 29th
Lat 19 34 N Long 106 27 W Fine weather
all this day with light airs from N.E. to E. S.W.
The ship heading to S.E. and so ends.

Monday November 30th
Lat 19 42 N Long 106 11 W Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship stered
by the wind and heading to S.E. All day all sail out
The watch employed in painting and so ends.

Tuesday December 1st
Lat 19 50 N Long 105 44 W Fine weather the
first part with light breezes from S.W. The ship heading
to S.E. The watch employed in painting the middle
and latter parts light variable wind with rain squalls
The ship heading to S.E. and so ends.

Wednesday December 2nd
Lat 19 00 N Long 105 10 W Fine weather most
of this day with fresh breezes from S.W. The ship
heading to S.W. and on different tracks during the
day all possible sail out and so ends.

Thursday December 3rd
Lat 19 32 N Long 106 50 W Rainy the first part
of this day the middle and latter parts pleasant. The wind
fresh and from S.W. by S. The ship stered by the wind
and heading to S.W. and all possible sail out and
so ends.

Friday December 4th
Lat 19 37 N Long 106 33 W Fine weather all this
day with fresh breezes from S.W. The ship stered by the wind
and heading to S.W. saw black fish. The watch
employed in ship duty and so ends.

Saturday December 5th
Lat 19 13 N Long 106 59 W Fine weather all this
day with light breezes from S.W. to S.E. with calms. The
ship stered by the wind and on both tack during the
day and so ends.

Sunday December 6th
Lat 19 33 N Long 106 40 W Fine weather all this
day and calm. Saw crampuses and so ends.

Monday December 7th
Lat 19 02 N Long 106 33 W Rainy the first and middle
parts and clear weather. The latter part light breezes from S.W.
with rain squalls. The ship stered by the wind and heading
to S.W. All sail out and so ends.

Tuesday December 8th
No Chart Rainy. The first part with light breezes
from S.W. The middle and latter parts light breezes from
the same quarter with a few light rain squalls. The ship
stered by the wind and heading from S.W. by N. to S.W.
All sail out and so ends.

Wednesday December 9th
Lat 19 06 N Long 106 51 W Fine weather most
of this day with light breezes from S.W. The ship
stered by the wind and heading to S.W. All sail out
The watch employed in repairing fore top gallant
sail finished and bent it and so ends.
