

Friday March 12th
Lat 12° 50' N Long 124° 45' W Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.E. & E. by N. All sail out the employes in ship duty and so ends

Saturday March 13th
Lat 12° 50' N Long 124° 59' W Fine weather all this day with the indications of a squall in the middle part. Fresh breezes all day from E. & S. by N. Course W. by N. All sail out and so ends. Stowed down 33 barrels of salt.

Sunday March 14th
Lat 12° 45' N Long 125° 57' W Fresh breezes from E. & S. by N. all this day with light rain squalls. Course W. by N. All sail out and so ends.

Monday March 15th
Lat 12° 44' N Long 126° 09' W Squally with fresh breezes from E. Most of this day with rain in the latter part. Course N. by W. All day all drawing sails set and so ends.

Tuesday March 16th
Lat 12° 44' N Long 126° 20' W Fine weather all this day with fresh trades. Course N. by W. All day all sail out and so ends.

Wednesday March 17th
Lat 12° 14' N Long 126° 35' W Cloudy most of this day with a little rain. And fresh trades. Course W. by N. All day all sail out. The cooper at work setting up shooks and so ends.

Thursday March 18th
Lat 11° 46' N Long 127° 14' W Cloudy most of this with a little rain and fresh trades. Course W. by N. All day all sail out. The cooper at work setting up shooks and so ends.

Friday March 19th
Lat 11° 55' N Long 127° 45' W Fine weather most of this day with fresh trades. Course W. by N. All day all sail out. The cooper at work setting up shooks and so ends.

Saturday March 20th
Lat 11° 58' N Long 128° 15' W Fine weather with moderate trades. Course W. by N. All sail out. The cooper at work setting up shooks and so ends.

Sunday March 21st
Lat 11° 56' N Long 128° 48' W Fine weather all this day with light trades. Course W. by N. All drawing sails set and so ends.

Monday March 22nd
Lat 11° 52' N Long 129° 10' W Fine weather all this day with light breezes from E. & S. by N. Course W. by N. All day all sail out. The watch employed in ship's duty and so ends.

Tuesday March 23rd
Lat 11° 58' N Long 129° 49' W Fine weather most of this day with light breezes from E. & S. The first part the middle and latter parts strong breezes from N.E. & E. The light sails in course W. by N. All day and so ends.

Wednesday March 24th
Cloudy most of this day with strong trades. At 5 P.M. saw the land. Made the middle and latter parts heading to the westward and for this hauled aback off Honolulu. At 12 M. and so ends.

Thursday March 25th
Fine weather. At 1 P.M. came to anchor on our side. The reef had hauled sails. The latter part was towed in side and anchored and commenced to strip ship and so ends.

Friday March 26th
Fine weather all this day. All hands employed in stripping the main mast to take it out, in hoisting up the mizen top mast and the head of the mizen with top mast went over the stern. The mizen mast being all gone with it, cleared the deck and so ended. At 3 P.M. broke the top mast in three pieces in the fall.
