

Saturday May 15th

Lat 2920 N Long 14105 W Fine weather all the day with light breeze from S.W. The ship started a number of courses during the day at 10 AM saw sperm whales and towed for them. And the Mr. C. B. boats struck and so ends. Mr. John Barrow refused to dart at a whale when ordered to by the Captain.

Sunday May 16th

Lat 2930 N Long 14058 W Cloudy The first and middle parts the barbed boat went off and got another whale got him along side and raised the middle part and saw 10 other whales along side the latter part cutting the water rainy with strong breeze from S.W. and so ends.

Monday May 17th

No Ober. Rainy the first part with fresh breeze from S.W. The ship heading to W. by W under short sail. All hands employed in clearing heads and cutting up blubber. The middle part cloudy with light rain. commenced boiling. The latter part cloudy with light breeze from S.W. to S.E. The ship heading to S.E. On the Peak in sight to N.W. 10 miles distant. All one sail in sight.

Tuesday May 18th

Lat 2916 N Long 14047 W Overcast most of this day with light variable winds. The ship steered a number of courses. Cruising and under short sail. boiling.

Wednesday May 19th

Lat 2927 N Long 14055 W Overcast most of this day with light breeze from S.E. The ship steered a number of courses during the day. Cruising at 11 PM finished boiling. The latter part the watch employed in clearing up decks and so ends.

Thursday May 20th

No Ober. Cloudy the first part. The middle and latter parts foggy with a little rain. A strong breeze from S.W. all day. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day under short sail and so ends.

Friday May 21st

No Ober. Foggy all this day with fresh breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and under short tacks during the day under short sail and so ends.

Saturday May 22nd

Lat 2938 N Long 14046 W Overcast most of this with thick fog at times. The wind light from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and under short sail and so ends.

Sunday May 23rd

Lat 2933 N Long 14047 W Foggy most of this day with sun and a light breeze from S.W. Ismely Peak in sight to N.W. 10 miles distant. The ship steered a number of courses cruising and so ends.

Monday May 24th

Lat 2938 N Long 14029 W Smoky most of this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered various courses during the day. Cruising. One sail in sight. The latter part all hands employed in stowing down oil and so ends.

Tuesday May 25th

Lat 2935 N Long 14042 W Fine weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. Finished stowing down blubber 84 bbls. Spoke of the the berg Miller & Collins, another sail in sight. The ship steered a number of courses during the day cruising and so ends.

Wednesday May 26th

Lat 2922 N Long 13953 W The first part quite fine with light breeze from S.W. The middle and latter parts rainy with light variable winds. The ship headed in all directions during the day cruising and so ends.

Thursday May 27th

Lat 2925 N Long 14046 W This day some sun and with light breeze from S.W. 4 PM No Ober. The remainder of today quite pleasant with light variable winds. The ship heading to W by S. On the Peak in sight. The first part
