Lat 3008 N Long 14049 E Smokey all this day  
The ship heading to N.W. the first part with light  
breeze from S.W. The sun set the Island of St. Peter  
low N.W. by 10 miles distant. The middle and latter  
parts fresh breeze from S.W. The ship steered a number  
of courses Cruising One sail in sight And so ends

Saturday May 29<sup>th</sup>

No Ob<sup>r</sup> Smokey all this day with fresh  
breeze from S.W. The ship off St. Peter the first part.  
Spoke the Brig William H. Allen. The middle and latter  
parts steered by the wind and on different tracks  
The Brig in company And so ends

Sunday May 30<sup>th</sup>

No Ob<sup>r</sup> Smokey with a little rain and a light  
breeze from S.W. Crabs peak in night bear W. Sun  
set 7 Miles distant. The ship steered a number of courses  
Cruising Saw fin backs. The Brig in company And  
so ends

Monday May 31<sup>st</sup>

Lat 29 00 N Long 14032 E Fine weather most  
of this day with calms and light air from S.W. The  
ship heading to S.E. passed Friday spoke to  
the Brig Allen, Saw fin backs And so ends

Tuesday June 1<sup>st</sup>

Lat 2846 N Long 14128 E Fine weather  
all this day with light variable winds The ship steered  
by the wind and on different tracks during the day  
heading from S.E. to S.W. One sail in sight  
And so ends

Wednesday June 2<sup>nd</sup>

Lat 2807 N Long 14111 E Fine weather all  
this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship  
steered by the wind and on different tracks during the  
day Spoke two in sight also one sail. The vessel  
employed in making spungum And so ends

Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup>

Lat 2740 N Long 14112 E Fine weather all this day  
with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind  
and on different tracks during the day. Spoke Group and  
the Bonnard Islands in sight also one sail And so ends

Friday June 4<sup>th</sup>

No Ob<sup>r</sup> Fine weather all this day with light  
breeze from S.W. The ship cruising off Baylis Island  
to S.W. One sail in sight also Black fish And so ends

Saturday June 5<sup>th</sup>

No Ob<sup>r</sup> Fine weather all this day with light breeze  
from S.W. The ship cruising off to S.W. at Baylis Island  
spoke the Brig William H. Allen, saw Black fish  
And so ends

Sunday June 6<sup>th</sup>

No Ob<sup>r</sup> Fine weather the first and latter parts  
The middle part calms The wind light and from S.W.  
The ship cruising off Baylis and Seal Islands saw  
black fish And so ends

Monday June 7<sup>th</sup>

Lat 2706 N Long 14267 E Fine weather all this  
day with light breeze from S.W. The ship cruising off  
Baley & Seal Islands. And so ends

Tuesday June 8<sup>th</sup>

No Ob<sup>r</sup> Smokey weather all this day with  
a fresh breeze from S.W. The ship off Baylis and the first  
part The middle and latter parts calms N.W. by W. and  
so ends

Wednesday June 9<sup>th</sup>

Lat 2620 N Long 14310 E Smokey the first and  
middle parts with a fresh breeze from S.W. bore with N  
by W until sun set we then shortened sail and hauled to  
the wind. The middle part steered by the wind and on both  
tracks The latter part fresh breeze from S.W. to N.  
The ship heading to N.E. raining hard and  
so ends
