

Thursday June 10th
No Obv. Rainy the first and middle part
with fresh breeze from N. The latter part clear weather
with a good breeze from NW. The ship steered by the
wind and on different tacks during the day And so
ends

Friday June 11th
No Obv. Clear the first part with light
breeze from NW. The latter part fog with light
breeze from N. One sail in sight And so ends

Saturday June 12th
No Obv. Light breeze S.W. The first and middle
The middle and latter parts fog and rainy. The ship
under short sail the wind variable the ship cruising
off the Peak, in sight the latter part bearing N. from
10 to 15 miles distant One sail in sight And so ends

Sunday June 13th
No Obv. The first part cloudy with light breeze
from N.W. The Peak in sight also one sail the middle
and latter parts thick and rainy. The ship hove to
under short sail the wind light and variable And so
ends

Monday June 14th
No Obv. Thick and rainy the first and middle
parts with a fresh breeze from N. The ship hove to under
short sail the latter part cleared up with a light
breeze from N. One sail in sight the ship heading to N.W. and
so ends

Tuesday June 15th
Lat 29 09 N Long 140 48 W. Clear weather all
this day with calms and very light breeze from N. The ship
heading to N.W. and so ends

Wednesday June 16th
Lat 29 17 N Long 140 29 W. Clear and calm the
first part the middle part light breeze from S.W. the
latter part strong breeze from the same quarter with rain
the Peak in sight bearing N.W. 12 miles distant headed to leeward
and bore soft sail and made all sail for a gale bearing to leeward

Thursday June 17th
No Obv. Thick and rainy with strong breeze
from S.W. The first and middle parts the ship
hove to under close reefed main top sail. The latter part
breeze and thick weather the ship heading to N.W. and so ends
under easy sail and so ends

Friday June 18th
Lat 29 15 N Long 140 16 W. Clear breeze all this
day with squalls of rain the wind from S.W. The ship
under short sail. The ship heading to the
eastward most of the day

Saturday June 19th
Lat 29 15 N Long 140 15 W. Clear weather most of
the day with light breeze from N. with calms. The
ship cleared by the wind and on different tacks
during the day the Peak in sight to N.W. and so ends

Sunday June 20th
Lat 29 45 N Long 140 15 W. Clear all this day
with light breeze from N.W. The first part the middle
part calm the latter part light breeze from N. The
ship cruising off the Peak and the Peak and so ends

Monday June 21st
No Obv. Clear most of the day with a fresh
breeze from N. The ship cruising between the Peak and the latter
both in sight and so ends

Tuesday June 22nd
No Obv. Clear the first part with fresh breeze
from N. The Peak in sight to N.W. The middle part strong
breeze from the same quarter the ship under short sail
the latter part moderate gales from N.W. The ship hove
to under close reefed top sail and heading to N.W. and so ends
bearing hard and so ends
