Lat 51° 10' Long 17° 41' W. Moderate gales from N.W. & S. with some rain the first, and middle parts. The ship here to heading to southward. The latter part strong breezes from N.W. & S. under easy sail. And so ends

Thursday November 18th
Lat 51° 45' Long 17° 41' W. Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from N.W. & S. The ship heading to S. until sunset without shortened sail and kept to heading to S. The latter part course S by N. The watch employed in repairing the main top gallant sail and so ends

Friday November 19th
Lat 52° 22' Long 17° 52' W. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship heading to S by N. The first and latter parts the middle part to S by the winds.

Saturday November 20th
Lat 52° 22' Long 17° 52' W. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship heading from S by N. to S. E. during the day. Steered a number of courses

Sunday November 21st
Lat 52° 48' Long 17° 52' W. Clear weather most of this day with fresh breezes from N.W. & S. The ship heading to the eastward. Steered a number of courses Cruising And so ends

Monday November 22nd
Lat 52° 10' Long 17° 52' W. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship steered a number of courses during the day Cruising And so ends

Tuesday November 23rd
Lat 52° 12' Long 17° 52' W. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship steered various courses. Cruising in Dept. An old 30c. pop sail. The latter part spoke the bar. Napoleon and had a gam And so ends

Wednesday November 24th
No Obv. Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from N.W. & S. The first part the middle and latter parts light breezes from the same quarters. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day

Thursday November 25th
Lat 51° 30' Long 17° 41' W. Overcast most of this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks and sail in sight And so ends

Friday November 26th
Lat 51° 30' Long 17° 41' W. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship heading to S by N. The N.W. 6 miles distant. The ship steered by the wind and heading to N. All day And so ends

Saturday November 27th
Lat 50° 10' Long 17° 52' W. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship heading to N. The first and middle parts. Sunday Island in sight to N. 10 miles distant at day light. The latter the ship heading to N.W. & S. saw a hump back And so ends

Sunday November 28th
No Obv. Fine weather with light breezes from N.W. & S. to N.W. & S. P.M. Sunday Island bearing S 20. miles distant saw a large sperm whale chased for him but did not get to him before dark. The ship steered by the wind all day And on different tacks And so ends

Monday November 29th
Fine weather with light breezes from N.W. & S. The ship steered a number of courses during the day Cruising Sunday Island in sight S.E. And so ends

Tuesday November 30th
Lat 52° 13' Long 17° 52' W. Overcast most of this day with a little rain and a light breeze from N.W. & S. The ship steered a number of courses during the day Cruising Sunday Island in sight And so ends
