Thursday December 2nd
Lat 23° 53' Long 179° 56' W. Fine weather all this day with light breezes from N.W. to S.W. The ship cruising Sunday and Goat Island in sight. And so ends

Friday December 3rd
No Obstr. Clear weather most of the day with light breezes the first and middle parts from S.W. to S. S.W. spoke the Northern light. The latter part fresh breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored by the wind and on different tack during the day. Goat Island in sight. And so ends

Saturday December 4th
No Obstr. Clear weather all the day with fresh breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored by the wind and on different tack during the day. Cruising Sunday and Goat Island in sight. And so ends

Sunday December 5th
No Obstr. Clear weather all this day with fresh breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship to the N. of Sunday Island. The first and middle parts Overcast in S.W. The latter part off and on the Island. Got off a lot of potatoes. And so ends

Monday December 6th
No Obstr. Clear weather all this day with fresh breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship off and on Sunday Island until 4 P.M. The Northern light in company. got off a lot of potatoes. And kept off to S. S.W. The latter part Goat Island and Curtis rocks in sight. And so ends

Tuesday December 7th
No Obstr. Clear weather most of this day with fresh breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored a number of courses during the day. Cruising. The latter part French Rock in sight. And so ends

Wednesday December 8th
No Obstr. Overcast most of this day with strong breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored by the wind and hoisting to S. S.W. under double reefed top sails. And so ends

Thursday December 9th
Lat 23° 59' Long 178° 40' W. Clear weather most of the day with strong double top sail breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored by the wind and on different tack during the day.

Friday December 10th
Lat 23° 40' Long 178° 51' W. Cloudy all this day with strong breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The first and middle parts the latter part the wind hauled to S. S.W. and blew a moderate gale. The ship hove to heading to N. W. very strong and so ends

Saturday December 11th
No Obstr. Strong gale from S.W. The first and middle parts with rain. The ship hove to under double reefed main top sail heading to N. W. S.W. blew the fore top mast staved all to the devil. The latter part clear and moderate the ship heading to N. under double reefed top sails. And so ends

Sunday December 12th
No Obstr. Clear weather all this day with fresh breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The first part the ship heading to N. W. under double reefed top sails. The middle and latter parts light breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored by the wind and on different tack. At 8 A.M. Goat Island bearing N.W. by N. 5 miles distant. Saw 3 sperm whales lowered for them but could not get near them. And so ends

Monday December 13th
No Obstr. Clear weather most of this day with light breezes from S.W. to S. S.W. The ship stored by the wind and on different tack during the day. Cruising. The latter part French Rock in sight. And so ends
