 Lat 38° 30' Long 179° 55' Fine weather all
 this day with light variable winds and calm at
 one point. Saw many whales lowered and chased then
 up to the surface. The latter part. Repairing the car
 and the lower part of the setting up shoes. And so
 ends

Thursday March 2nd
 Lat 38° 35' Long 179° 54' Clear weather and
 light variable winds. The first part two sails in
 sight. The middle and latter part strong breeze
 from E. The ship heading to Southward by the
 wind. Spoke the bark Sonia.

Friday March 3rd
 Lat 38° 32' Long 179° 36' Clear weather all
 this day with fresh breeze from E. The first part
 the middle and latter part light breeze from
 the same quarter. The ship steered various courses
 during the day cruising.

Saturday March 4th
 Lat 38° 40' Long 179° 59' Fine weather all
 this day with calm the first and middle parts.
 The latter part light breeze from W. Course E by N
 One sail in sight And so ends

Sunday March 5th
 Lat 38° 39' Long 179° 31' Fine weather
 all this day with light breeze from W. The ship
 heading to E and E by N. Most of the day two sails
 in sight And so ends

Monday March 6th
 Lat 38° 42' Long 179° 07' Fine weather all
 this day with light breeze from W. The first part the
 ship heading to N. E. The middle part have E head
 yards aback. The latter part light breeze from E
 by N and land and cutting rocks in sight to Eastward
 also three sails in sight. The ship steered by the
 wind heading to N. E. And so ends

Tuesday March 7th
 Lat 38° 50' Long 178° 55' Fine clear weather
 all this day with light breeze from E. The ship
 cruising between Sunday and Boat Islands And
 so ends

Wednesday March 8th
 Fine weather with the
 light breeze from E. The first and middle
 parts the ship heading to E. N. The latter
 part strong breeze from E. E. with rain the
 ship heading to E under easy sail And so ends

Thursday March 9th
 Lat 38° 50' Long 178° 30' Strong breeze from E
 with rain squalls at one P.M. saw sperm whale
 lowered for them and all three boats struck the
 boat and got the others cut out in before dark
 the latter part cut in the other and boiling
 the ship heading to N. E. And so ends

Friday March 10th
 Lat 38° 47' Long 178° 50' Clear weather all
 this day with very strong breeze from E. At one P.M.
 saw sperm whale lowered and the boat struck
 it. Put him up, and the latter part cut him
 in. Boiling and so ends

Saturday March 11th
 Lat 38° 52' Long 179° 50' Clear weather all
 this day with strong breeze from E. The first part
 the middle and latter part fresh breeze from the
 same quarter. The ship steered by the wind and on
 different tacks during the day. Boiling and so ends

Sunday March 12th
 Lat 38° 52' Long 179° 40' Clear weather
 most of this day with fresh breeze from E. E. M.
 finished boiling. The ship steered by the
 wind and on different tacks during the day
 saw one sail
