on the rigging And so ends

Wednesday April 27th
All hands on board employed in fitting
rigging And so ends

Thursday April 28th
Rainy all this day One watch on liberty
The other employed in ships duty. Andrew Enates
deserted

Friday April 29th
Rainy the first and latter parts One watch
on liberty The other employed in ships duty And so
ends

Saturday April 30th
Rainy the middle part One watch on liberty
One man, Deserted, got George. The other watch
employed in ships duty

Sunday May 1st
All hands on board employed in getting
off recruits And so ends

Monday May 2nd
Clear weather all this day with light breeze
from S.W. The first part At 4 P.M. we got under weigh
with a Pilot And stood out into the bay about 8 miles
and anchored again. The middle and latter parts calm
Shipped two new men and a boy

Tuesday May 3rd
Clear weather the first and middle parts
At one P.M. we got under weigh with a light breeze from
S.W. and stood out to sea. spoke the Cleone
bound in. The Jonia in company. The middle
part fresh breeze from S.W. Course N.E. by
N. All part out The latter part squally with
fresh breeze from E.S. Drift heading to N.W.
And so ends

Wednesday May 4th
No Wind. Cloudy with strong breeze from
E.S. The ship heading to E.N.E. The first and
part of the middle part. The remainder of the day
The ship have to heading to W. with a strong
gale from E. And so ends

Thursday May 5th
No Wind. Strong gales from E. to E.S. with
rain squalls The ship have to under close reefed main
top sail and storm say sails heading to Northward
And so ends

Friday May 6th
No Wind. Moderate gales from N. the first
part. over ship and have to heading to E. The middle
and latter parts moderate the wind from N.E. by
course N.E. by E. And so ends

Saturday May 7th
Lat 32.02 Long 17.45 Clear weather all
this day with light breeze from N. Course same
E.S. The watch employed in ships duty
And so ends
