 of this day with light breezes from S.E. to E.S.E.
 The ship heading to N.W. by N. until sunset, we
 then tacked. The remainder of the day the ship
 heading from S to E by S. All sail out, and
 so ends

Tuesday May 31st
 Lat 32 00 Long 133 00 W Overcast most
 of this day with fresh breezes from N.W. to E. The first
 part all sail out. The middle and latter part
 strong breezes from S.W. to N.W. The light
 sails in. Course E. All day and so ends

Wednesday June 1st
 Lat 32 30 Long 132 10 W Overcast the first
 part with strong breezes from N.W. to E. The middle
 part rainy and strong breezes from S.W. to double
 reefed and handed the main sail. The latter
 part the hauled to N.W. and cleared up the
 wind ~~and~~ all drawing sails. Course E. All day
 and so ends

Thursday June 2nd
 Lat 33 36 Long 132 21 S. W. Overcast most
 of the first and middle parts with fresh breezes from
 N.W. to E. The latter part clear weather with
 fresh breezes from E. Course E by N. All day and so ends

Friday June 3rd
 Lat 33 32 Long 132 28 W Clear weather
 most of this day with strong breezes from E. The first
 part the middle and latter parts light breezes
 from S.W. to N. Course E by N. All day and so ends

Saturday June 4th
 Lat 33 24 Long 132 38 W Clear weather
 with light air from N.W. to E. The first part
 the middle part strong breezes from S.W. to double
 reefed, Course E by N. All day and so ends

Sunday June 5th
 Lat 33 45 Long 132 00 W Fresh gales from
 N.W. to E. The first and middle parts with light
 rain squalls. Course E. Under double reefed. The
 latter part strong breezes from N.W. to E. Course E. N. E.
 All drawing sails set and so ends

Monday June 6th
 Lat 33 55 Long 132 32 W Clear weather most
 of this day with fresh breezes from N.W. to E. Course E by N.
 The first and middle parts and E. The latter part
 All drawing sails set and so ends

Tuesday June 7th
 Lat 33 40 Long 132 10 W Clear weather the
 first and middle parts with fresh breezes from N.W.
 The latter part rainy with fresh breezes from
 N.W. to E. Course E by N. All day All
 drawing sails set. And so ends

Wednesday June 8th
 No Clear Overcast the first part with strong
 breezes from N.W. The middle and latter part
 very strong breezes with heavy squalls and rain
 Clouds raised the main and double reefed the fore
 top sail. Course E. N. E. The first and middle parts
 and E by N the latter part and so ends

Thursday June 9th
 Lat 33 37 Long 132 40 W Strong breezes from
 N.W. The first part the top sail in. The middle
 and latter parts fresh breezes from the same quarter
 with rain squalls. All drawing sails set. Course
 N. E by E. All day and so ends

Friday June 10th
 N. E. by E squalls with rain and a fresh
 breeze from N. E. The first part the middle and
 latter parts pleasant with variable winds. Set the
 to N. E. N. Course N. E by E. All day and so ends
 drawing sails set and so ends
