Saturday June 25<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 12° 45' Long 104° 33' W. Fine weather  
all this day with fresh breezes from S.E. Course N.  
The first part the watch employed in painting  
ship. The latter part, I saw sperm whales, lower  
and the boat struck, turned him up and  
got him along side. He N. N. got ready to cut  
And so ends

Sunday June 26<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 10° 40' Long 104° 20' W. Overcast, most  
of this day with strong breezes from S.E. The ship here  
to practice all hands employed in cutting in the  
whale. Parted one chape front one eye and the chon  
shap and lost one hook overboard got the head  
of And body in. And so ends

Monday June 27<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 10° 33' Long 104° 30' W. Clear weather all  
this day with strong breezes from S.E. Finished  
cutting the whale the first part and proceed forward  
and shot to. The remainder of the day under short  
sail. Bailing. And so ends

Tuesday June 28<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 10° 32' Long 105° 07' W. Clear weather all  
this day with strong breezes from S.E. The ship  
heading to under easy sail, bailing. And so  
ends

Wednesday June 29<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 11° 00' Long 105° 20' W. Fine weather all  
this day with fresh breezes from S.E. Finished bailing  
the first part. The ship heading to Wall day  
by the wind under double reefed Top sail. And  
so ends

Thursday June 30<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 10° 02' Long 105° 30' W. Fine weather all the  
day with fresh breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the  
wind and heading to N.E. All day. And so ends

Friday July 1<sup>st</sup>  
Lat 8° 18' Long 104° 15' W. Fine weather all this  
day with fresh breezes from S.E. The ship heading to N.E.  
by the wind all day. The first part, covered all the  
latter part all hands employed in stowing down.  
Slowed 83 bl. 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> gal.

Saturday July 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Lat 6° 30' Long 104° 51' W. Fine weather all this day  
with fresh breezes from S.E. Course N. by E. All day.  
The watch employed in ships duty. And so ends

Sunday July 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Lat 4° 40' Long 103° 51' W. Fine weather all this  
day with light breezes from S.E. Course N. by S.  
All day. And so ends

Monday July 4<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 4° 33' Long 103° 42' W. Fine weather all  
this day with light breezes from S.E. Course  
N. by S. The first and latter parts the middle  
part none to. The watch employed during the  
day painting ship. And so ends

Tuesday July 5<sup>th</sup>  
Lat 4° 43' Long 106° 38' W. Fine clear  
weather all the day with light breezes from S.E.  
The ship heading to N. by E. A.M. saw sperm  
whales, lower and the boat struck  
turned them holes up. And so ends
