Lat 45° 55' Long 108° 04' Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from E.S. The ship
steered a number of courses during the day. Cruising
Spoke Bark Thornton, saw a number of fin backs
And so ends

Monday July 18th
Lat 45° 00' Long 108° 41' Smokey weather
with light rain squalls most of this day. The
ship steered by the wind and on different tacks
during the day. One sail in sight. And so
ends

Tuesday July 19th
Lat 45° 58' Long 108° 00' Smokey weather
all this day with fresh trades. The ship steered
by the wind and on different tacks during the
day. One sail in sight. The watch employed in
ships duty. And so ends

Wednesday July 20th
Lat 45° 05' Long 108° 48' With smoky weather
all the day with fresh trades. The ship steered
by the wind and on different tacks during the
first and middle parts. The latter part saw
sperm whales going quick to the lowered and
chased them the remainder of the day. And
so ends

Thursday July 21st
Lat 44° 40' Long 108° 36' Fine weather
all this day with light trades. The ship heading
to N.E. the first part sperm whales in sight
to windward. The middle part hove to head
y and so backs of S.E. saw sperm whales again
lowered and chased the remainder of the day.

Friday July 22nd
Lat 40° 00' Long 108° 00' Fine weather all
this day with light trades, chasing whales the
first part. The ship struck and shot a whale
entirely in the latter part and sperm whales
boiling the ship heading to E. S. E. by the
wind. And so ends

Saturday July 23rd
Lat 40° 25' Long 108° 55' Fine weather all
this day with light trades. The ship steered by the
wind and on different tacks during the day. Boiling
saw a bark to windward setting a whale. And so
ends

Sunday July 24th
Lat 43° 55' Long 109° 10' Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from E.S. Finished
sailing the latter part. The ship steered by the
wind all day and on different tacks during the
time. Lots of fin backs around.

Monday July 25th
Lat 44° 00' Long 109° 03' Fine weather all
this day with light trades. The ship steered by the
wind and on different tacks during the day. One sail
in sight. And so ends

Tuesday July 26th
Lat 44° 00' Long 108° 29' Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from E.S. The ship
steered by the wind and on different tacks during
the day. Lots of fin backs around. The latter part
all hands employed in stowing down our last
catch of oil, 42.66 lbs. S. gal. And so ends

Wednesday July 27th
Lat 44° 00' Long 107° 50' Fine weather all this
day with light trades. The ship steered by the wind
and on different tacks during the day. One sail
in sight. And so ends

Thursday July 28th
Lat 44° 10' Long 107° 13' Fine weather all
this day with light trades. One sail in sight. The
ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during
the first and middle parts. The latter part came
on. And so ends. Lots of fin backs around
