

Friday August 12<sup>th</sup>

Lat 10° 47' N Long 100.00 W Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the wind and heading in E.N.E. all day and so ends

Saturday August 13<sup>th</sup>

No Wind Overcast all this day with light breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the wind and heading to E.N.E. all day all sail out and so ends

Sunday August 14<sup>th</sup>

Lat 10° 03' N Long 99.01 W Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the wind and heading to E.N.E. the middle part and to E. by N the first and latter part all sail out and so ends

Monday August 15<sup>th</sup>

Lat 11° 41' N Long 97.22 W Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the wind and heading to E. and E by N all day all sail out the water employed in repairing the fore top sail and so ends

Tuesday August 16<sup>th</sup>

Lat 13° 4' N Long 96.00 W Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from S.E. Course by E. The first part the middle and latter parts steered by the wind and heading from E to E by S. and so ends

Wednesday August 17<sup>th</sup>

Lat 12° 0' N Long 94.25 W Overcast most of this day with fresh breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the wind and heading to E by N and so ends

Thursday August 18<sup>th</sup>

Lat 13° N Long 92.5 W Overcast most of this day with light breezes from S.E. The ship steered by the wind and heading to E by N. The main mast in sight to N. and so ends

Friday August 19<sup>th</sup>

Lat 14° N Long 92.33 W Overcast most of this day with fog and light airs from S.E. with calms. The sail down at 4. The ship heading to E.N.E. all day and so ends

Saturday August 20<sup>th</sup>

Lat 15° N Long 92.39 W Overcast most of this day with light airs from S.E. The ship heading to E.N.E. all day all sail out and so ends

Sunday August 21<sup>st</sup>

No Wind Overcast most of this day with breezes from S.E. The ship heading to E.N.E. all day The latter part back Dundas and the only thing in sight. The ship also no sail. Looked after boats around and so ends

Monday August 22<sup>nd</sup>

No Wind Overcast most of this day with light airs and calms. The ship heading to E.N.E. all day. Back Dundas in sight to E. 28 miles distant. Boat of Sulphur Bottom around and so ends

Tuesday August 23<sup>rd</sup>

Lat 23° N Long 91.45 W Overcast the first and middle parts with light airs from S.E. The first part calm the middle part. The latter part light breezes from S.E. The ship heading to E.N.E. Back Dundas and the latter in sight and so ends

Wednesday August 24<sup>th</sup>

Lat 23° N Long 91.40 W Clear weather most of this day with light breezes from S.E. at 4 P.M. Dundas back bearing 1.68 miles distant. Saw two large sperm whales bounding and spouting from the ship at sunset. The latter part all hands employed in cutting and so ends
