

Thursday September 7th
No Ob^r thick weather most of this day with light rain squalls. The wind is from the S.W. steered by the wind and on different tacks. Menman Island in sight during the day.

Wednesday September 6th
Lat 21° N Long 173° 40' W. Light breeze from S.W. all this day with a few light squalls. The first and middle parts. Menman Island in sight. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks. The latter part heading to C.M.C. by the wind. And so ends.

Thursday September 8th
Lat 21° 15' N Long 173° 55' W. Overcast most of this day with light breeze from S. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks during the day. The Cooper at work setting up shacks. And so ends.

Friday September 9th
No Ob^r Overcast the first and middle parts with a little rain and a light breeze from S. Menman Island in sight to W. S. The ship steered by the wind and on different tacks the first and middle parts. The latter part heading to C by the wind. And so ends.

Saturday September 10th
Lat 21° 35' N Long 174° 22' W. Clear weather most of this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship heading to C by N by the wind. At one P.M. saw breaches which proved to be a small whale. Lowered the boats for them at 3 P.M. and the boat struck a small whale turning him up and got him to the ship at sunset. The latter part put him in and commenced repairs. The ship heading to S.W. by the wind. And so ends.

Sunday September 11th
Lat 21° 15' N Long 174° 26' W. Clear weather all this day with light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the wind and heading from S by N to C.M.C. Finished boiling the whale tallow. up 26.

Monday September 12th
Lat 21° 17' N Long 174° 40' W. Overcast most of this day with a fresh breeze from S. The ship steered by the wind heading to Eastward the first and middle parts. The latter part course C. The light sails in. The Cooper at work setting up shacks. And so ends.

Tuesday September 13th
Lat 21° 35' N Long 174° 22' W. Clear weather all this day with a good breeze from S. Course C the first and latter parts. The middle part here to head yards. Back. The Cooper at work on shacks. And so ends.

Wednesday September 14th
Lat 21° 08' N Long 174° 04' W. Clear weather most of this day with light breeze from S.W. Course C the first part, sinker & the fore top sail and bent another the middle part heading to S under short sail. The latter part course C. Repaired the main top sail. And so ends.

Thursday September 15th
Lat 21° 44' N Long 174° 50' W. Overcast most of this day with mist squalls and a good breeze from S.W. Course C the first part the middle and latter parts heading to C by the wind. And so ends.

Friday September 16th
No Ob^r Overcast all this day with a good breeze from S.W. The ship heading to C. And S by N all day. The watch employed in making spungon. Carried away the water 18 of day.
