Sunday September 18<sup>th</sup>  
Saw 48 of seals 22:30 AM Overcast most of  
this day with light breeze from S.W. and  
the ship heading to S.W. by the wind. The first  
part the middle to W. by the wind. The latter part  
the boat of seals in sight. Joint St. Helena  
and so on.

Monday September 19<sup>th</sup>  
Saw 137 of seals 8:25 AM Overcast most  
of this day with light breeze from S.W. The  
ship steered by the wind and on different tacks  
during the day. Joint St. Helena and the  
boat in sight. Lots of humpbacks around and  
so on.

Tuesday September 20<sup>th</sup>  
No Obv<sup>r</sup> Overcast most of this day with  
light breeze from S.W. The ship steered by the  
wind and on different tacks during the first and  
middle parts. The latter part heading to S.W.  
by the wind. At 11 AM came to an anchor at  
ombaye and so on.

Wednesday September 21<sup>st</sup>  
Fine weather. Sunk the sails and got  
a raft of casks on shore for water and so on.

Thursday September 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Fine weather all hands employed in  
getting water. And so on.

Friday September 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Fine weather all hands employed in  
getting off water and recruited and so on.

Saturday September 24<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather all hands employed in getting  
water and recruited and so on.

Sunday September 25<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather all hands employed in getting  
water and got off a raft. At 11 AM the ship ready for sea  
and so on. The cook drunk. And in irons.

Monday September 26<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather all this day. At 11 AM went  
underweigh with the wind from S.W. and so on.  
And so on.

Tuesday September 27<sup>th</sup>  
No Obv<sup>r</sup> Clear weather all this day with  
fresh breeze from S.W. The first part the middle  
and latter parts strong breeze from S.W. and the  
light sails. The ship steered by the wind and  
on different tacks during the day. Making  
up along shore and so on.

Wednesday September 28<sup>th</sup>  
No Obv<sup>r</sup> Overcast most of the day with  
fresh breeze from the first and middle parts  
the latter part light breeze from the same  
quarters. The ship steered by the wind and on  
different tacks during the day. Making to wind  
ward along the land. One sail in sight and  
so on.

Thursday September 29<sup>th</sup>  
No Obv<sup>r</sup> Overcast most of this day with  
light breeze from S.W. by the wind and on different  
tacks during the day making to wind ward along  
the land and so on.

Friday September 30<sup>th</sup>  
Overcast with fresh breeze from S.W.  
At 4 PM we came to an anchor at ombaye and  
hauled the sails. The latter part all hands employed  
in making ship and so on.
