

Wednesday February 1st
Lat 23° 11' Long 112° 23' W. Clear weather all
this day with fresh breezes from the first and middle
and part of the latter part. Topgallant sails in
the remainder of the day light trades. All sail
out, sent the Main Course and sent the yard aloft
the ship steering by the wind all day and heading
from S. by E. to E.

Thursday February 2nd
Lat 23° 14' Long 112° 29' W. Fine weather all
this day with light trades the first and middle
parts the ship heading from S. by E. to E. The
latter part breezes from S. by E. Course E. All sail
out all day. The watch employed in cleaning
iron work and so on.

Friday February 3rd
Lat 23° 15' Long 112° 35' W. Fine weather all
this day with light breezes from S. and S. by E. The
ship heading from S. by E. to E. The first part
Course E. The middle and latter parts. All sail
out and cooping oil. And so on.

Saturday February 4th
Lat 23° 15' Long 113° 0' W. Clear weather all
this day with light breezes from S. by E. The first
part Course S. by E. All hands employed in
stowing back sail. The middle and latter parts
light breeze from S. by E. with calms. The ship head-
ing S. by E. and so on.

Sunday February 5th
Lat 23° 15' Long 113° 0' W. Clear weather all
this day and calm most of the time and so
on.

Monday February 6th
Lat 23° 16' Long 110° 45' W. Clear weather all this
day with light breezes from S. by E. Course S. by E. All
sail out and so on.

Tuesday February 7th
Lat 23° 40' Long 110° 18' W. Clear weather with
light breezes from S. by E. The first and middle parts the
Course S. by E. The latter part calm. And so on.

Wednesday February 8th
Lat 23° 40' Long 107° 32' W. Breezes from S. by E.
to E. Most of this day with a head swell. The ship
heading from S. by E. to E. Light sails in. Repaired
the main top mast say sail and so on.

Thursday February 9th
Lat 23° 14' Long 108° 06' W. Clear weather all this
day with fresh breezes from the first part the
light sails in. The middle and latter part light
part of light breezes from S. by E. All sail out. The
ship steering by the wind all day and heading
from S. by E. to E. And so on.

Friday February 10th
Lat 23° 15' Long 107° 32' W. Clear weather
all this day with light breezes from S. by E. to S. by E.
The ship heading from S. by E. to E. The first part
Course S. by E. The middle and latter parts. All sail
out. The watch employed in ships duty and
so on.

Saturday February 11th
Lat 23° 40' Long 108° 42' W. Clear weather
all this day with very light breeze from S. by E. to S. by E.
Course S. by E. All sail out. The watch employed
in ships duty and so on.

Sunday February 12th
Lat 23° 40' Long 104° 55' W. Clear weather all
this day with calms and very light airs from different
quarters Course S. by E.

Monday February 13th
Lat 23° 37' Long 101° 10' W. Clear weather the
first and latter parts the middle part rainy.
Calm and light airs from different quarters
all this day Course S. by E. The watch employed
in ships duty and so on.
