tacks during the day. Under double reefed fore sails
And so ends

Wednesday March 16th
Lat 35 20 Long 75 20 Clear weather all
the day with strong breeze from S. E. The fore
several sails in sight. The middle and latter
parts fresh breeze from S. E. The ship close
to heading to S. W. Under easy sail And
so ends

Thursday March 17th
Lat 35 19 Long 76 11 Moderate gales the first
and middle part. from S. E. The ship close to heading
to S. E. The latter part fresh breeze from the same
quarter. At 7 A. M. saw sperm whales. Long and
the boat struck and got turned over and the
line and whale. Several sails in sight And so ends

Friday March 18th
Lat 35 00 Long 76 20 Fresh breeze from S. and
cloudy with a nasty swell on. Landed again for whale oil and
and the boat struck and got a whale got him to the ship
At sunset. The latter part butting a sail in sight
cutting And so ends

Saturday March 19th
Lat 34 18 Long 76 49 Fine weather all the
day with light breeze from S. The first part. The ship heading to
S. E. The middle part calm. The latter part light breeze
from N. by N. E. Boiling all this day. Two sails in
sight And so ends

Sunday March 20th
Lat 33 18 Long 76 58 Fine weather all this day
with light breeze from S. E. The ship heading to S. E.
by the wind. The latter part spoke a few small
Boiling all this day

Monday March 21st
Lat 33 00 Long 77 30 Fine weather all the

thin backs around And so ends

day with variable winds from N. to S. The ship
steered various courses during the day. Two sails
in sight And so ends

Lat 33 54 Long 79 00 Clear and calm most of the
day with light breeze from S. E. The first and middle
