 No Ob<sup>r</sup> - Overcast all this day with strong  
 breeze from N.N.W. All this day with rain the  
 middle part the ship stand by the wind  
 and a different tack during the day. Under  
 short sail. Several sails in sight. Plenty of  
 fire backs around And so ends

Sunday March 24<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 38' Long 74° 10' W. Moderate gale all  
 this day from N.E. The ship have to under short  
 sail and a different tack during the day. Several  
 sails in sight And so ends

Monday March 25<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 35' Long 74° 40' W. Moderate gale from  
 N.E. The first and middle part. The latter part  
 calm and a very heavy swell on. Several sails in  
 sight And so ends The ship heading to N.W.

Tuesday March 26<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 07' Long 74° 14' W. Fine weather all  
 this day with light breeze from N.E. The  
 ship heading to N.W. by the wind N.E.  
 7 A.M. saw 3 sperm whales to windward going  
 quick. Saw sails in sight. Chased them whales  
 with the ship. The remainder of the day And  
 so ends

Wednesday March 27<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 35' Long 74° 40' W. Fine weather all  
 this day with light breeze from N.E. The ship  
 heading to N.E. At 1 P.M. lowered boats for whale  
 And the boat struck and got 4 whales. The middle  
 part heading to N.E. What along side the latter  
 part cut him in. Several sails in sight Lots  
 of black fish and fire backs around And so ends

Thursday March 28<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 38' Long 74° 18' W. Fine clear weather all  
 this day with light breeze from N.E. to N.W. The ship  
 heading to N.W. by the wind. The middle and latter  
 parts from N.E. to N. Several sails in sight. Baling  
 all this day And so ends

Friday March 29<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 34' Long 74° 36' W. Fine weather all this  
 day with light breeze from N.E. to N.W. The ship  
 heading to N.W. by the wind. The middle and latter  
 parts from N.E. to N. Several sails in sight. Baling  
 all this day And so ends

Saturday April 1<sup>st</sup>  
 Lat 33° 29' Long 74° 52' W. Fine weather the first  
 part with light breeze from N. course. Several sails  
 in sight. The middle and latter parts light breeze from  
 N.E. The ship heading to N.W. by the wind. The middle  
 and latter parts from N.E. to N. Several sails in sight.  
 And so ends

Sunday April 2<sup>nd</sup>  
 No Ob<sup>r</sup> - Chick and rainy calm the first part  
 the middle and latter parts light breeze from N.E.  
 The ship stowed by the wind and on.  
 Different tacks during the day. Several sails in sight  
 And so ends

Monday April 3<sup>rd</sup>  
 Lat 33° 05' Long 75° 00' W. Fine weather all this day  
 with light breeze from N.E. The ship heading to N.W.  
 The middle and latter parts from N.E. to N. The  
 middle and latter parts from N.E. to N. The latter part  
 employed in stowing oil. Stowed 65 bbls. Fresh breeze  
 from N.E. and in sight. St. Margys And so ends

Tuesday April 4<sup>th</sup>  
 Lat 33° 05' Long 75° 00' W. Fine clear weather all this  
 day with light breeze from N.E. The ship heading to N.W.  
 The middle and latter parts from N.E. to N. The middle part  
 heading to N.W. by the wind. The latter part heading  
 in for Calcuttana. At 4 P.M. went to anchor And so  
 ends The day At 9 P.M. went to anchor And so ends  
 Calcuttana. And landed the sail. And so ends
