Monday 10

This day commences with a calm and thick weather middle light W. wind later part breeze and thick crew employed in trying out two ships in sight plenty of ice

Tuesday 11

This day commences with a strong breeze from the N. W. middle and later part the same crew employed in ships duty one ship in sight ends this day

Wednesday 12

This day commences with a strong E. wind middle and later part the same some ice in sight and one ship the midas crew employed in trying out ends this day

Thursday 13

This day commences with a strong E. wind and thick weather middle part the same later part clear crew employed in stowing down six ships in sight spoke the harbor boat ends this day

Friday 14

This day commences with a strong E. wind and

Thick weather middle and later part clear lowered the boats for whales succeeded in catching six stove two boats crew employed in trying out two ships in sight ends this day

Saturday 15

This day commences with a strong N. wind middle and later part the same crew employed in stowing down one ship in sight lowered the boats

Sunday 16

This day commences with a strong N. wind and foggy weather middle and later part the same one ship in sight plenty of ice

Monday 17

This day commences with a calm and thick weather middle part the same later part strong breeze crew employed in backing out and stowing down one ship in sight

Tuesday 18

This day commences with calm and thick weather middle part the same later part light breeze and clear at noon a crew lowered the boats for whales succeeded in capturing sixty seven eight ships in sight spoke the Arctic and also Logda ends this day

Wednesday 19

This day commences with a strong E. wind and fine weather middle and later part the same crew employed in flanching blubber ten ships in sight spoke the Josephine ends this day

Thursday 20

This day commences with a strong S. E. wind middle and later part the same crew employed in ships duty number of ships in sight spoke the Sea breeze plenty of ice at land ends this day

Friday 21

This day commences with light breeze from the E. middle part Calm later part the same saw several Denish started the tryworks crew employed in muzzing blubber one sail in sight the S. B. Captains came on board and got some place
