in clearing the ship Sunday 2.

This day commences with a light N. wind and
fine weather middle and later part calm at seven A.M. lowered
the boats for Devil fish the Starboard Boat struck took him
aboard side and commenced cutting finished cutting at
eight P.M. and set the watch Monday 3.

This day commences with a S. breeze and thick
weather middle and later part the same at eight lowered the
Boats for Devil fish but no success crew employed in
washing ship so ends this day Tuesday 4.

This day commences with thick weather and calm
middle and later part clear at four A.M. lowered the boats
at seven A.M. lowered the three boats the Starboard Boat struck
and drewed from the Devil fish started the tryworks one
ship in sight so ends this day Wednesday 5.

This day commences with a thick fog middle and
later part clear lowered the boats for Devil fish the Starboard
Boat struck and drewed crew employed in trying one
so ends this day Thursday 6.

This day commences with a thick fog middle and
later part clear at six A.M. lowered the boats for D.F. the
Starboard Boat struck and got stove and cut the line and
lost the whale came on board at ten A.M. and commenced
striking down finished trying down at six P.M. and set
watch on Friday 7.

This day commences with thick rainy weather middle
and later part the same crew employed in ship duty
ends this day Saturday 8.

This day commences with a strong N. W. wind
and thick weather middle and later part the
same the crew variously employed

Sunday 3.

This day commences with a strong N. W. wind
middle and later part the same making slow
progress. At twelve A.M. this day spoke the Cutace
of San Francisco. Capt. Smith Monday 1. of July 1812.

This day commences with a light N. W. wind and
fine weather middle part the same later part strong breeze ends this
day strong N. by Compass Tuesday 2.

This day commences with a light S. wind and
weather middle and later part the same lowered the boats for
walrus succeeded in capturing thirty spikes the Bagdad
ends this day Wednesday 3.

This day commences with a light S. wind and fine
weather middle and later part the same lowered the boats
for walrus succeeded in catching three spikes the Maunyo
and the Jack Perry ten ships in sight ends this day
Thursday 4.

This day commences with a light S. wind and fine
weather middle and later part the same lowered the
boats for walrus succeeded in catching twenty six
ten ships in sight Friday 5.

This day commences with a strong N. W. wind
and thick weather middle and later part the same
lowered the boats for walrus but no success crew employed
in skinning blubber one ship in sight Saturday 6.

This day commences with a light S. wind and
fine weather middle and later part the same lowered
the boats for walrus succeeded in capturing sixteen
two ships in sight Sunday 7.

This day commences with a strong N. wind and good
weather middle part the same later part thick fog lowered the
boats but no success at six P.M. lowered the boats succeeded
in catching eleven one ship in sight Monday 8.
