This day commences with a strong S. wind and fine weather middle and later part the same the variously employed one ship in sight so ends this day A. O

Saturday 13

This day commences with a light N. W. wind and rainy weather middle part clear later part thick snow storm the crew variously employed one ship in sight

Sunday 14

This day commences with a strong N. wind and thick weather middle and later part the same some ice in sight one ship in sight so ends this day steering by the wind on the track

Monday 15

This day commences with a light N. wind and thick weather middle and later part clear and employed in skinning blubber started the tryworks spoke the R. side of N. B. twenty months out 850 B

Tuesday 16

This day commences with a light N. E. wind and thick weather middle and later part the same crew employed

in trying out spoke the W. B. word of H. B. L. two ships in sight at ten p.m. hauled the boat for walrus succeeded in catching thirteen

Wednesday 17

This day commences with a light N. wind and fine weather middle and later part the same at eight A.M. hauled the boat for walrus succeeded in catching nine spoke the Florence of San Francisco two ships in sight

Thursday 18

This day commences with a light N. wind and rainy weather middle part clear later part foggy crew employed in stowing down so ends this day

Friday 19

This day commences with a calm and thick weather middle part the same later part clear the crew variously employed one ship in sight Saturday 20
This day commences with a light N. wind and thick rainy weather middle part clear later part strong S. wind crew employed in ships duty spoke the R. H. Wood three ships in sight

Sunday 21

This day commences with a light S. wind and clear weather middle and later part the same hauled the boat for wood spoke the R. H. Wood three ships in sight at five p.m. dropped our port bow in seven fathoms of water so ends this day

Monday 22

This day commences with a light N. wind and thick weather middle part the same at two p.m. hauled the boat to go in shore for wood at three p.m. took our anchor at four let go our anchor at five p.m. dropped our anchor and made sail working slowly to N. four ships in sight

Tuesday 23

This day commences with a thick fog middle part clear later part the same crew employed in working ships spoke the Florence three ships in sight Wednesday 24
