Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the E. ship heading to the S.E. employ in various work all jobs sail in sight middle part pleasant latter part employ in useful jobs sail in sight

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S.E. ship heading to the S. the watch employ in ships but sail in sight middle part pleasant all drawing sail set latter part employ in useful jobs

Saturday September 12th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the E. ship heading to the S.E. with all drawing sail set the watch employ in ships but middle part pleasant latter part ship heading to the S.E. sail in sight the watch employ in useful jobs

Sunday September 13th

Begins with moderate breezes and fair weather from the E. ship heading to the S.E. with all drawing sail set sail in sight middle part the same latter part pleasant ship heading to the S.E. with all drawing sail set

Tuesday September 22nd 1857

Begins with light breezes and hazy weather from the S.E. ship heading to the S. with all drawing sail set employ in repairing the wire topsail middle part tacked ship and to the S.E. latter part squally rain took it the top about 10 ft of jib and gaff the wheel the foremast

Wednesday September 23rd

Begins with very strong breezes and cloudy weather from the S. ship heading to the S.E. at 3 P.M. set the jib and one repair of the topsails still flying and the part the same latter part squally employ in ships but nothing in sight

Lat by Obs 26.42 Long by Chron 34.40

Thursday September 24th

Begins with strong breezes and squally weather from the S. ship heading to the S.E. with all prudent sail employ in ships but at 4 P.M. the middle part of the jib and the jib and under part of the foremast employ in repairing the jib

Lat by Obs 25.55 Long by Chron 34.50

Friday September 25th

Begins with very strong breezes and squally weather from the S. ship heading to the S.E. employ in repairing the jib it is finished and bent it and the latter part much the same.
