

Bark Canby Packet S. Log Book ^{I took on this road to 1800 A}

Friday October 9th 1857

Begins with moderate breezes and squally weather from the S.E. at 12 M. hauled and by up E. employ in cleaning iron work and other useful jobs nothing in sight middle part moderate latter part breaking out the fore sail for shooke.

Latitude by Obs 16.55 S Longitude by Obs 58.22 W

Saturday October 10th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S.E. ship heading to the W. employ in stowing of the fore sail spoke the Hibernia of New Bedford 3rd months out clear middle part pleasant latter part employ in ships duty.

Latitude by Obs 16.45 S Longitude by Obs 58.10 W

Sunday October 11th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S.E. ship heading to the S.W. employ in ships duty at sundown took in the main top galant sail and by jobs middle part pleasant latter part saw a bark steering S.W.

Latitude by Obs 15.20 S Longitude by Obs 58.40 W

Monday October 12th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S.E. ship heading S.W. nothing in sight at sundown took in the main top galant sail and by jobs and hauled up the main sail middle part at 12 mid in the ship to the E. latter part employ in taking down Latitude by Obs 18.37 S Longitude by Obs 58.47 W

Cruising Up St Helena

Tuesday October 13th 1857

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S. steering S.E. employ in taking down rigging saw four barks at sun down short two sail to topsails and fore to the main heading to the E. middle part the same latter part at 4 more ship to the S.W. employ in taking down rigging

Latitude by Obs 18.07 S Longitude by Obs 58.22 W

Wednesday October 14th

Begins with moderate breezes and lower weather from the S.E. steering S.E. employ in taking down rigging at sundown lifted to the main and the up S.W. middle part steady latter part employ in breaking out and regulating the fore shole

Latitude by Obs 14.00 S Longitude by Obs 60.12 W

Thursday October 15th

Begins with moderate breezes and squally weather from the S.E. at noon wore ship and shored it employ in stowing of the after bolt at 4 P.M. lifted and by up S.E. by E. middle part latter part much the same

Latitude by Obs 18.01 S Longitude by Obs 58.59 W

Friday October 16th

Begins with strong breezes and clear weather from the S.E. ship heading to the S.E. employ in washing ship and other useful jobs middle part strong breeze latter part employ in ships duty

Latitude 16.5 S Longitude by Obs 58.18 W
