

Bark. Lumber Packets. Log Book.

Monday January 11th 1858.

Begins with moderate breezes and hazy weather from the S.E. ship heading in edging at 8 pm finished and commenced boiling milt. and latter part began head Latitude 36° 20' S Longitude 16° 40' E.

Tuesday January 12th

Begins with moderate breezes and fair weather from the S. ship heading to the S.W. employed in boiling milt. part finished the head and commenced in the latter part same Latitude 37° 09' S Longitude 16° 15' E.

Wednesday January 13th

Begins with moderate breezes and fair weather from the S. ship heading to the S.W. employed in boiling at 4 o'clock down for rain at 7 P.M. spread all old fore-sail, for an evening and shook the masts again milt. and latter part fair Latitude 36° 58' S Longitude 16° 15' E.

Thursday January 14th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S. ship heading to the S.W. employed in boiling spoke the foremast of Santuckel 40 months out to 8 o'clock latter part finished boiling and washed up Latitude 36° 58' S Longitude 16° 15' E.

Friday January 15th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S. ship heading to the S.W. spoke the mast at 12 o'clock 19 months and 2500 pm milt. part finished latter part strong down in the main hatchway Lat 36° 40' S Long 16° 55' E.

Cruising On New Zealand

Sunday January 16th 1858

Begins with strong breezes and clear weather from the E. ship heading to the S.E. under double reefed top-sail and courses milt. and latter part much the same Latitude 32° 45' S Longitude 16° 20' E.

Monday January 17th

Begins with strong breezes and pleasant weather from the E. ship heading to the S.E. at tacked ship to the S.E. under short sail milt. part the same latter part employed in ships duty at noon tacked to the E.S.E. Latitude 32° 30' S Longitude 16° 15' E.

Tuesday January 18th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather from the S.E. ship heading to the E.S.E. under at sail section in right employed in various jobs milt. part pleasant latter part equal from the S. ship heading to the E.S.E. Latitude 32° 58' S Longitude 16° 52' E.

Wednesday January 19th

Begins with strong breezes and clear weather from the S. ship heading to the E.S.E. under short sail employed in ships duty nothing in sight milt. part milt. E.S.E. ship heading to the S.E. at 8 tacked to the S. latter part saw junks
